

Interaction with Swiss neighbors during 2013 – 2014

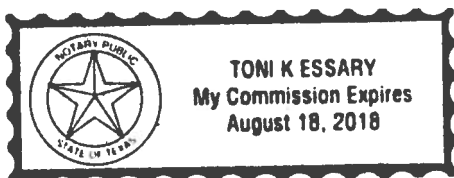
