Lane Plating Works, Inc.

Proposed to the National Priorities List January 2018



The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), in conjunction with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality, has announced the proposal of the Lane Plating Works, Inc. site (Site) on the National Priorities List (NPL). The NPL is EPA's list of uncontrolled or abandoned hazardous waste sites identified for long-term cleanup under the federal Superfund program. The Site is located in Dallas, Texas. The Site is being proposed to the NPL because of the presence of contaminants in surface water.

Community members are invited to comment on the proposal to place the Site on the NPL. A 60-day public comment period began on January 18, 2018, and ends March 19, 2018.
