



HAZARDOUS AND NON-HAZARDOUS SPILLS WORK INSTRUCTIONS

YES - As safely as possible, USING PROPER PPE, stop the discharge of materials from the container or other source.



Yes - Use absorbent to contain the spill

YES - Shut off any ignition source that could cause a fire in the vicinity of the discharged materials

YES - Asking for assistance from the closest available person contain the spill using absorbent or other containment devices such as socks or pads located in the waste yard



Yes - Sweep up the absorbent

Using a broom, spread the absorbent until the spill is absorbed

YES - Place the spent absorbent in proper containers and store in the appropriate storage area



No - Don't put the absorbent in the trash, use the proper container

YES - Report spills to first available supervisor.



No - Don't forget to call your supervisor and notify OEQ and SWM

For spills over one gallon report to OEQ at (214) 670-1200. For any spill that enters a storm drain or a waterway, report to Storm Water Management (311 or 214 948-4407). For spills over the Reportable Quantity, report to the appropriate state and federal authorities.
