- 3. **DEICING FLUID IS PROHIBITED FROM ENTERING STORM DRAINS DURING DRY WEATHER EVENTS.** Cover all storm drains where the deicing/anti-icing process will occur. Collect and remove the deicing/anti-icing residual remaining on the ground to the full extent in which pooling no longer exists. This should take place as soon as possible after the completion of each deicing procedure.
- 4. Properly dispose of the collected material.
- 5. Keep daily forms in your SWPPP addendum along with the SDS. This requirement applies for all deicing chemicals, in addition to glycols. All SDS forms must be provided to the DOA.
