

## Raytheon Love Field (SIC 4512)

*Subtenant of Associated Air*

Raytheon Love Field conducts routine maintenance of aircraft.

This includes removing and installing engines, and avionics. They do not perform major engine overhauls or participate in any aircraft deicing activities or other deicing other than routine deicing of the sidewalks entering the building. There is no fueling done at this location. Occasional aircraft washing is done outside, with all drainage diverted to the industrial sewer.

Diesel or Gasoline powered industrial trucks are used to move aircraft into and out of the hangers. Diesel trucks are used to bring equipment to the site. The trucks are often parked outside, where they can be exposed to stormwater.

There is a trash compactor located outside. The trash container is closed, but some exposure could occur at the loading chute. There are also containers for recycled wood and metal. Compacted bales of clean cardboard are occasionally stored outside.

There is no known significant runoff to the site from adjacent properties. The site does not meet the requirements of EPCRA 313 and does not report under that regulation.
