For purposes of this paragraph, a principal executive officer of a federal agency includes the chief executive officer of the agency, or a senior executive officer having responsibility for the overall operations of a principal geographic unit of the agency (e.g., regional administrator of the EPA).

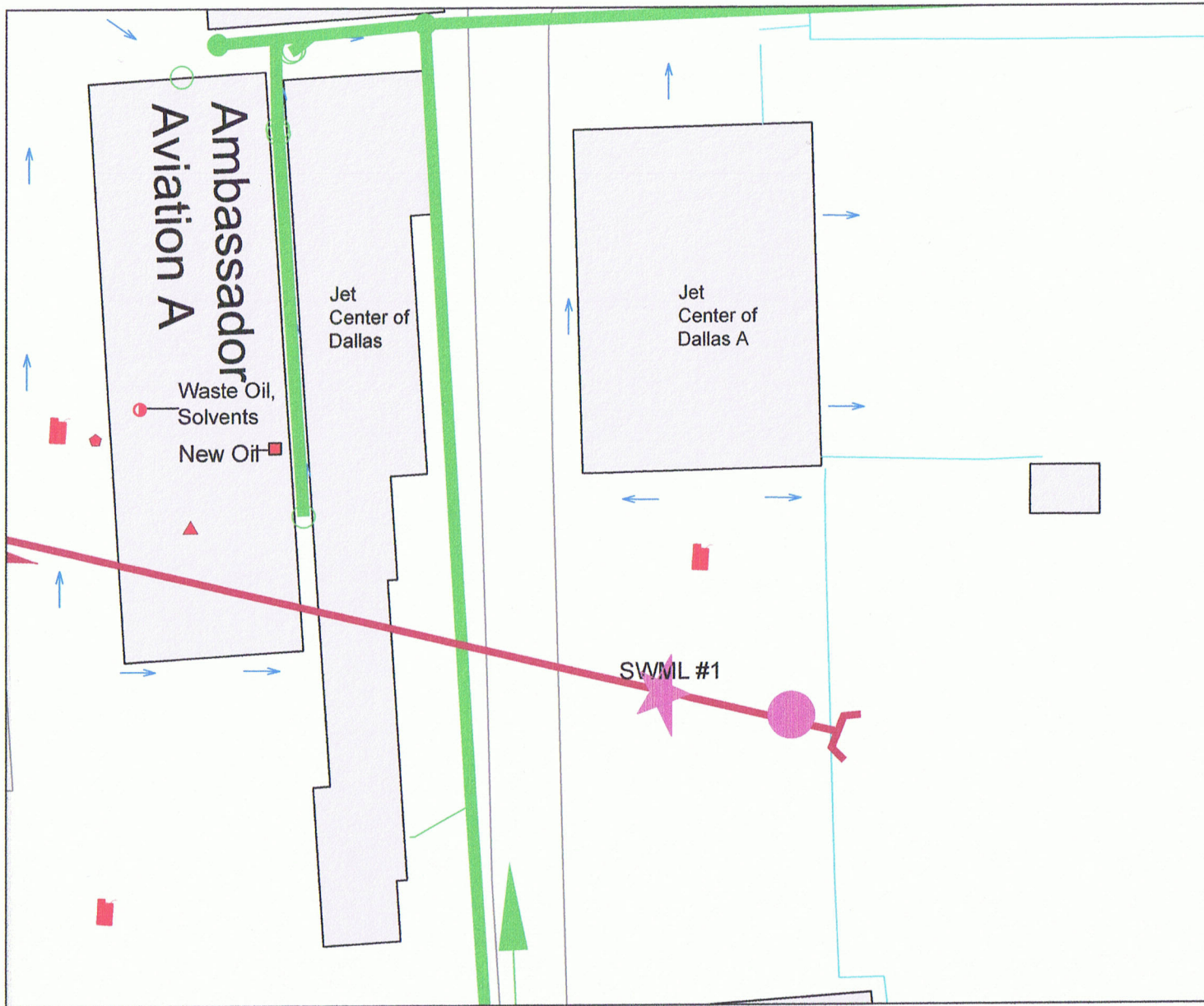

Ambassador Jet Center is a large Fixed-Base Operator (FBO) at Dallas Executive Airport, offering Box and T-hangar rentals to sub-tenants. No aircraft or vehicle painting occurs on the Ambassador Aviation leasehold. Dry washing of aircrafts may be conducted from time to time. No deicing activities occur at this facility. Ambassador controls a fuel farm with 1-10,000 gallon UST for Jet A, 1-10,000 gallon UST for Avgas, 1-1,000 gallon UST sump tank for waste fuel. Ambassador maintains two fuel trucks a 3,000 gallon truck with Jet A and a 750 gallon truck with Av-gas.

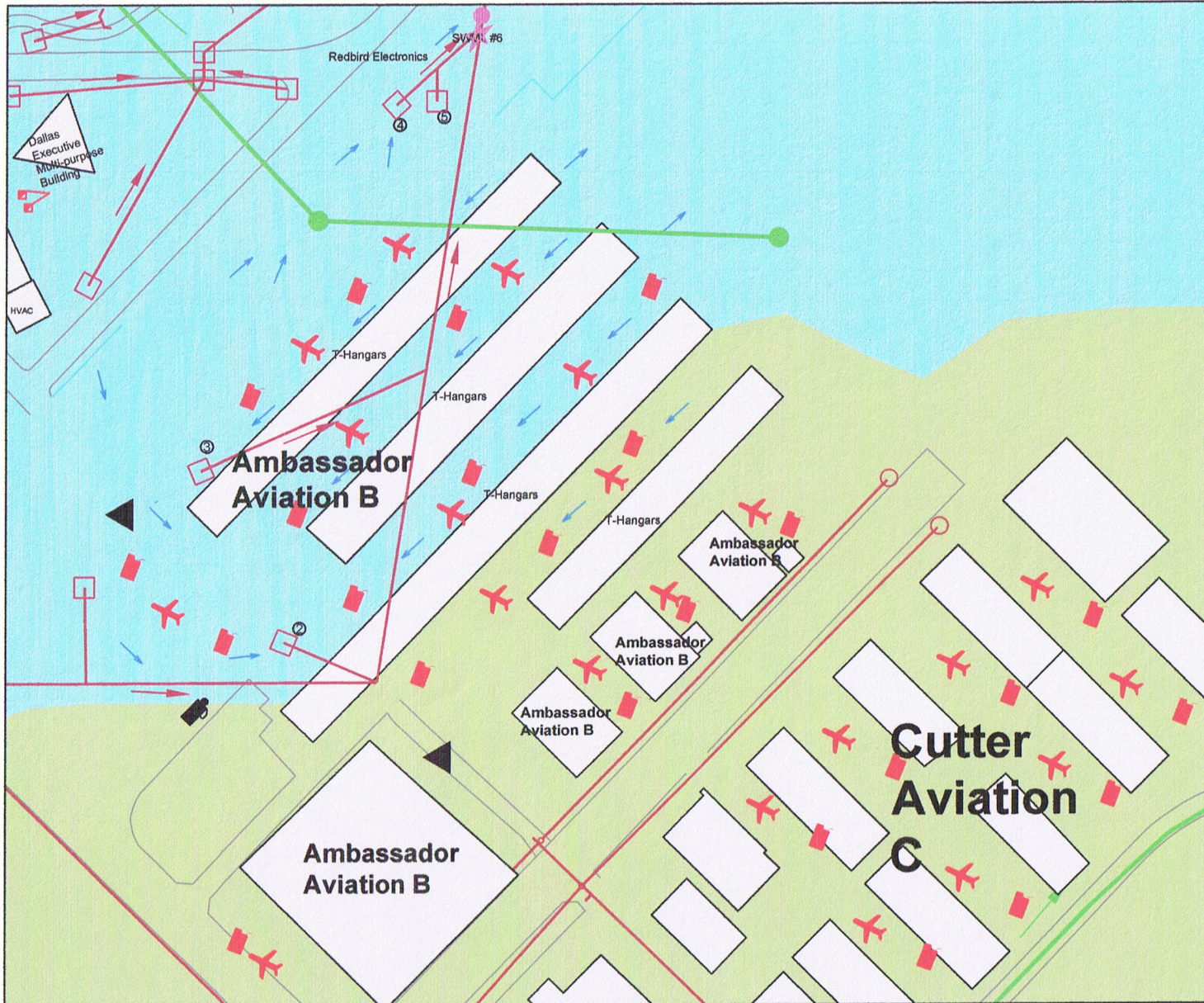

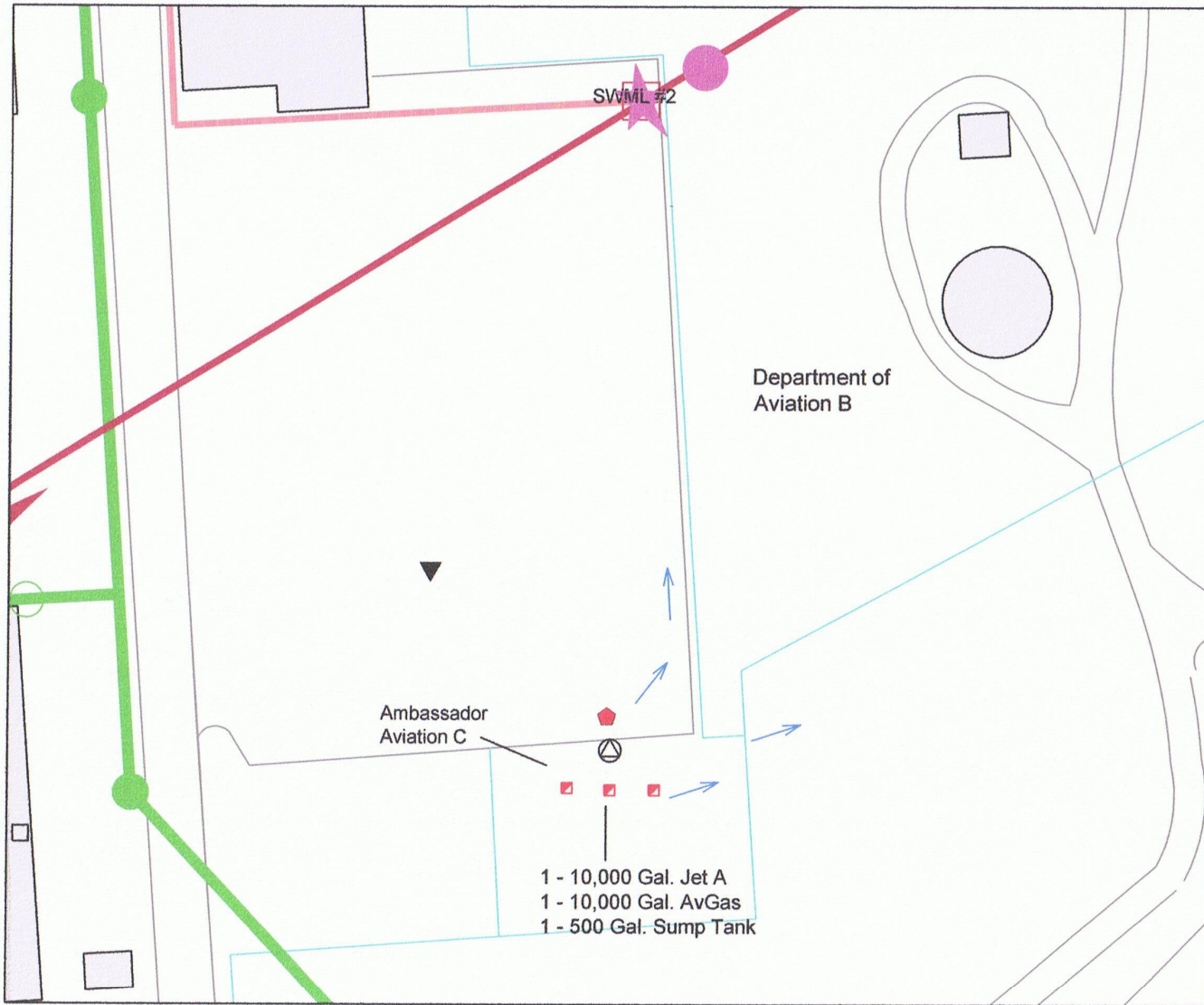
