- 1. Empty standing water where possible.
- 2. For standing water that can't be emptied, such as an ornamental pond, stock Gambusia fish (minnows that eat mosquito larvae) or use a Bti (Bacillus thuringiensis 'israelensis') product such as Bactimos Briquettes.
- 3. Spray for adult mosquitoes with garlic products orange oil and other plant oil or citronella.
- 4. Use organic management to encourage birds, bats, dragonflies, and other beneficial insects.
- 5. Use skin repellents that contain natural herbs such as aloe vera, citronella, eucalyptus, tea tree, and citrus oil.
- 6. Bug light devices do not work! They kill more beneficials than the pests.
- 7. Broadcast cedar granules on the ground where mosquitoes are a problem.
