

August 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016 Comparison




Live Release Rate for Dogs & Cats is up from 20.6% in August 2011 to 59.0% in August 2016

August 2013, 2014, 2015, and 2016 Comparison




1,530 Total Live Releases of Dogs & Cats for August 2016, up from 487 in August 2011

August 2013, 2014, 2015, and 2016 Comparison




August 2016 humane euthanasia of dogs and cats at 1,074, down from 1,879 in August 2011
