

May 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016 Comparison




Live Release Rate for Dogs & Cats is up from 21.0% in May 2011 to 59.1% in May 2016



May 2013, 2014, 2015, and 2016 Comparison




A new record May low for humane euthanasia of dogs and cats at 1,061, down from 2,211 in May 2011
