
September 2016 Live Release Rate

September 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016 Comparison




Live Release Rate for Dogs & Cats is up from 26.6% in September 2011 to 64.1% in September 2016

September 2013, 2014, 2015, and 2016 Comparison



September 2013, 2014, 2015, and 2016 Comparison




September 2016 humane euthanasia of dogs and cats at 903, down from 1,572 in September 2011
