## KEEPING PETS & PEOPLE TOGETHER

In November, DAS launched a partnership with Home To Home™, an online platform that allows residents to proactively rehome their pets when keeping them is no longer an option. Home To Home™ helps pets stay out of shelters by allowing them to go directly from an old home to a new one, preventing overcrowding and saving shelter resources for pets with no other options. Those seeking to adopt can use Home To Home's™ search feature, and when they find a pet they're interested in, they can easily communicate with the person that knows the animal best - the current owner. The DAS Pet Support Team also works with users to provide information and support to help make a successful match with an adopter. DAS saw 120 pets submitted through Home To Home™ in November and December and 19.2% have already found positive outcomes outside the shelter.

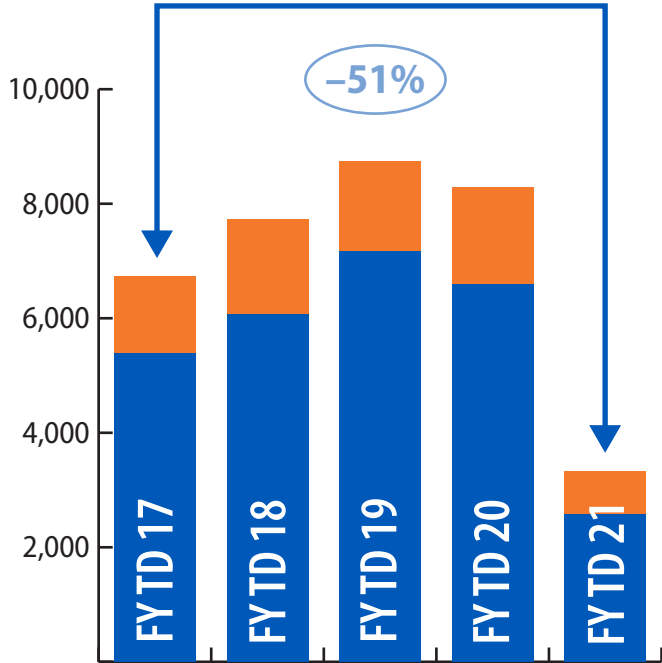

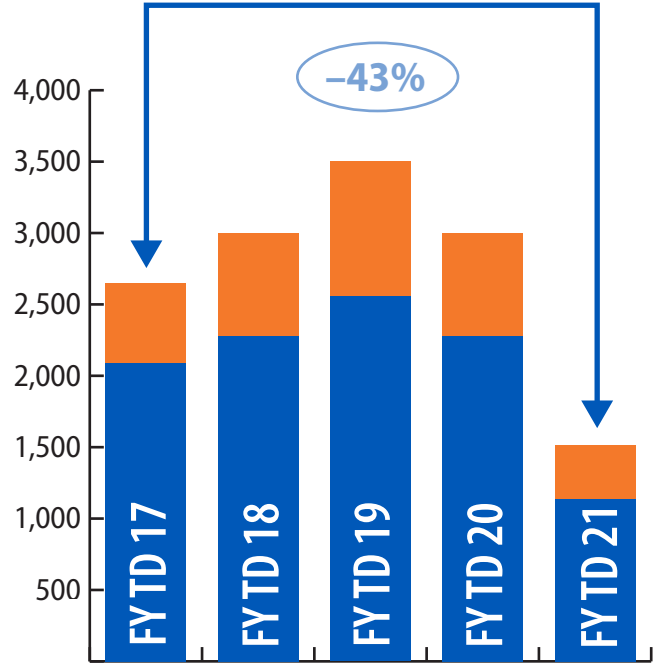
# YEAR OVER YEAR COMPARISONS\*

## TOTAL INTAKE

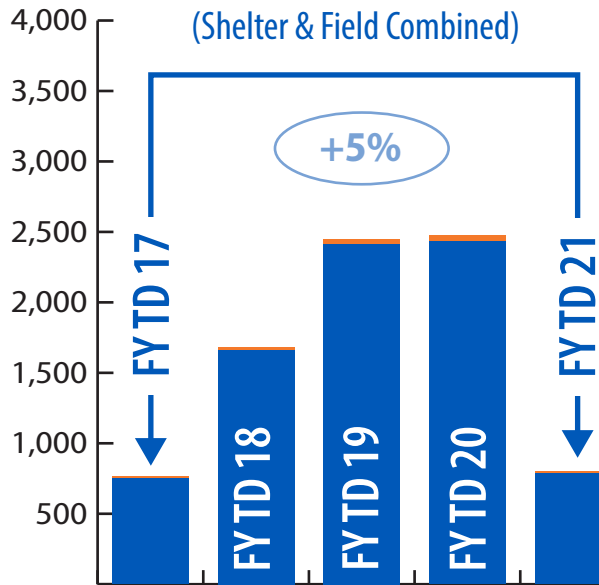

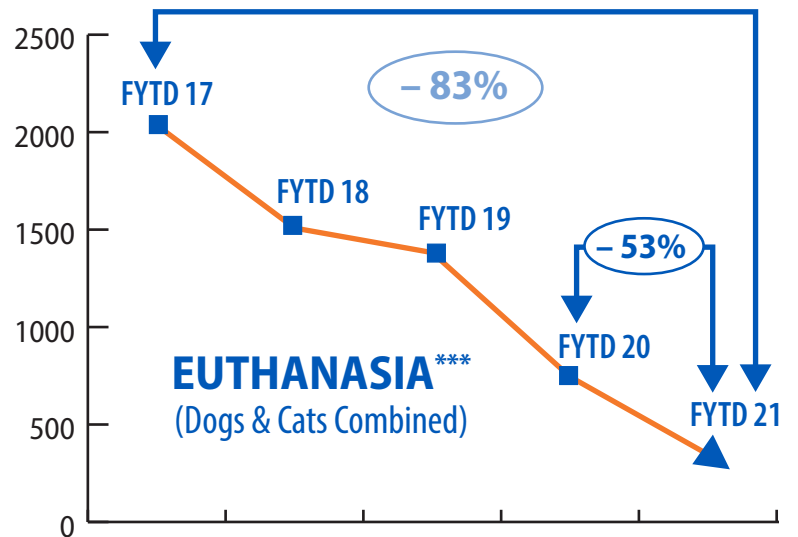

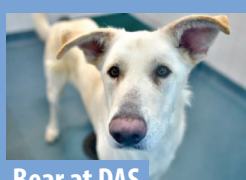
