This is to serve notice to the City of Dallas that I will not make any personal appearances before this commission until my redistricting attorney on Voting Rights Act issues has had the opportunity to review all of the public and confidential notices and efforts that I have submitted, to including but not limited to, the City Attorney McAninch, Acting Secretary Rosa Rios, City Managers Ryan Evans and Forrest Turner, Councilmembers Griggs, Margolis, Davis, Carraway, and through at least three end of public commission meeting speakers forums and through civil disobedience under the threat of removal and criminal trespass of my objections to Commissioners Garcia and Loza giving directives to the public to protect incumbents, or berate public submitters for refusing to remove poor minorities from a richly laden preston hollow district, or having Brashear tell a former Plaintiff when criticizing the chair, that the Commission is not interested in the past, or condesending remarks from Halstead that district 10 provides charitable opportunities to the disadvantaged when the issue here is to provide electoral opportunities , Garcia or staff determining what is retrogression or gerry mandering, minority commissioners not provided full legal advice on how to properly make ther intent through motions,. interrogating the public to disclose their financial interests when commissioners are not allowed to disclose theirs. I want to know how many contracts do Ratcliff and Brashear have with other governmental bodies through Willis Johnson and does Brashear want UNT in District 5 so that he can get both DART and UNT engineering cntracts.

I have privately noticed the City Attorney of my confidential personal concerns and until my personal attorney and I can be assured that somebody other than me bring objections to those concerns, I cannot appear before this body in the audience or at the mike and probably not at City Hall period.

Please provide the commissioners a copy of my opposition to Woods proposed map accept this as my after the meeting public comments by reading this into the record at the appropriate time.

I am opposed to Pct 36 being removed from District 12 for the following reasons : Given that the City often enters into interlocal agreements with other governmental bodies, I would like to advise the commissioners of the following for their consideration is at least two of several areas.

The City of Dallas contracts with Dallas County Elections Department to hold their elections (which are now limited to mandatory election dates.)

For the City of Dallas Mayorial and city council elections, Dallas Co. is allowed by law to conduct out of county elections. For May elections, the County must retrieve voter data from Rockwall, Kaufman, Denton, and Collin counties. For November elections when the city holds proposition or referendum elections, the City of Dallas has to contract with the 5 aforementioned counties.

To put Pct 36 in a Dallas County based City of Dallas based council district will separate the Collin county Dallas residents from their communities of interests in other governmental districts because State representatives are limited to apportionment within one county as are they are with all county government officials. For example, Pct 36 will have a Collin County state representative, such that when there are interlocal discussions about their property and quality of life, District 11 may be represented by a resident who lives in Collin County but services on the Dallas City Council and may find themselves in conflict with positions that maybe held by a District 12 resident elected from Dallas County. Yes ,the same could be in reverse but Dallas County has more City of Dallas based elected state officials with urban interests than the other counties state officials that may have more rural interests. There all kinds of issues including DART, smoking ban, liquor that have competing interests in Austin. With only one Pct in Collin County in Pct. 11, those resident's opportunity to elect someone with their Collin County interests is diluted. This is not a protected issue for the "bleached" make up of Collin County City of Dallas residents, therefore some prudence and respect for all citizens to have that same protection should outweigh the interests of the few from Dallas County side that seek to draw them out.

Further, since there is low disadvantaged population in 12 and 11, the Supreme Court has relaxed its deviation requirements in the Voting Rights Act to allow for a higher deviation in the North or non- disadvantaged areas to allow for a smaller deviation in the Hispanic populated areas to increase their voting strength percentages.


