- Build neighborhood identity and capability

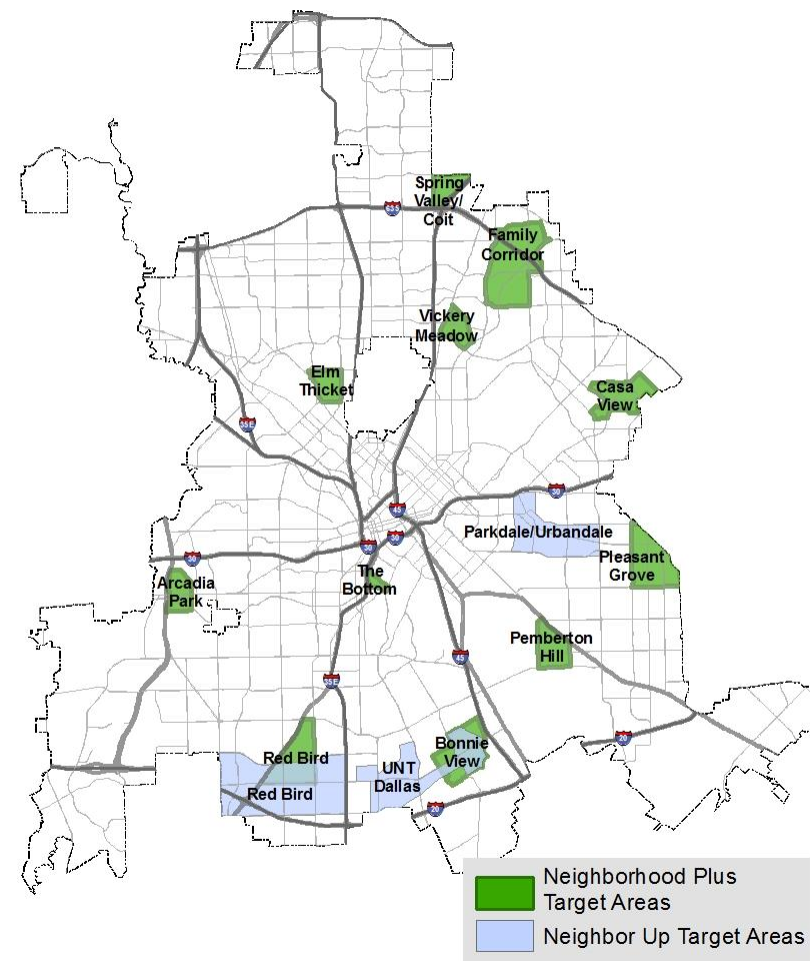
Neighborhood Plus
