DISCUSSION

(1) DCA212-005 Consideration of amending the definitions of bedroom, kitchen and bathroom in the Dallas Development Code.

Ms. Levy read the item into the record and presented updates to the proposed amendments to the Dallas Development Code Chapter 51 and 51A to revise the definitions for bedroom, kitchen and bathroom in support of the Comprehensive Environmental Climate Action Plan (CECAP) goals of reducing storm water runoff and reducing the heat island effect. The Committee asked staff questions and offered suggestions to add clarity to definitions.

Motion to move case DCA212-005 to City Plan Commission with the following recommendations:

- 1. Replace "used for sleeping" with "designed for sleeping" in the proposed definition of Bedroom in 51A-2.102(9).
 - a. Updated proposed definition: BEDROOM means any room or area in a dwelling unit designed for sleeping other than kitchens, dining rooms, living rooms, bathrooms, closets, game rooms, sunrooms, and other similar rooms.
- 2. Add, "or cooktops" to "ovens, or stoves" in the proposed definition of Kitchen in 51A-2.102(57.1).
 - a. Updated proposed definition: KITCHEN means any room or area used for cooking or preparing food and containing one or more ovens, or stoves, <u>or cooktops</u>; one or more refrigerators; and one or more sinks. This definition does not include outdoor cooking facilities.
