McCommas Bluff Landfill Safety Rules

If you have or observe an emergency, please call 9-1-1 and notify a landfill employee at once.

- 1. Safety first! Anyone behaving in an unsafe or unprofessional manner will be required to leave the landfill.
- 2. Landfill equipment operators have the right of way on the active disposal area. All vehicles must yield to operating machinery and to pedestrians.
- **3.** Be aware of moving landfill equipment and other vehicles and maintain safe following distance. **Do not pass moving vehicles.**

4. UNAUTHORIZED SCAVENGING AND SALVAGING IS PROHIBITED.

- 5. Obey all posted traffic and speed limit signs. Speed limits for paved roads are 20 mph. Unpaved roads have a speed limit of 10 mph.
- 6. Cell phone use is prohibited when customers are on or beyond the scales.
- 7. All vehicles are subject to random inspection by Landfill personnel.
- 8. All persons and vehicles enter the Landfill at their own risk. The City of Dallas assumes no liability for bodily injury, personal injury, or property damage while on Landfill property.
- All children, pets, and adults not involved in unloading of refuse shall remain inside the vehicle at all times. Children under 16 and pets are not permitted in disposal areas.
- 10. Restricted materials shall not be disposed of in any portion of the Landfill.
- 11. Smoking is not permitted within the processing area.
- 12. Alcoholic beverages and illegal drugs are not permitted. Obviously intoxicated or impaired customers will not be permitted to enter the facility.
- 13. Unauthorized access is not permitted outside of posted operating hours.
- 14. Commercial customers shall wear high-visibility vests and/or clothing while outside of their vehicle.
- 15. Commercial customers may turn boxes, clean out hoppers and remove/replace tarps in designated areas only.
- 16.In the event of a collision or spill of petroleum product please notify Landfill personnel. Do not move vehicles involved in a collision or a spill until asked to do so by emergency responders. The driver or their employer will be required to clean up and remove spilled materials.
- 17. Any unattended vehicles will be towed at the owner's expense unless authorized by expressed written consent of the facility manager or their designee.
- 18. The City of Dallas assumes no liability for damage to vehicles resulting from towing or otherwise assisting disabled vehicles.
- 19. No repairs or maintenance to customers' vehicles are to be performed on City of Dallas property without expressed written consent by the facility manager or their designee.
