Addition of a valid contractor to an existing **master permit** may be accomplished by mail or FAX, or by phoning any district office listed in this pamphlet.



HOW TO GET A LAWN SPRINKLER PERMIT

INSTALL A LAWN SPRINKLER OBTAINING A MASTER PERMIT? SYSTEM?

A master (trade) permit must be obtained before installing any lawn irrigation system, which is permanently connected to the city's water supply.

A permit is not required when making repairs to the piping of an existing lawn irrigation system, unless the back-flow prevention device is being replaced.

WHAT IS A MASTER PERMIT?

Building Inspection issues a "master permit" which represent the authorization for all types of work on a construction project. Installation of a lawn sprinkler may be a part of a project or it may be the only type of work to be done. In either case, a master permits is required.

WHEN IS A PERMIT REQUIRED TO WHAT ARE THE PROCEDURES FOR

The following are required for a master permit:

- Completed permit application form.
- Two sets of plans drawn to a standard scale. All drawing documents submitted for review must have a minimum text size of 3/32" and a minimum drawing sheet size of II" x I7" and a maximum of 36" x 48", "E" size.
- Irrigation plan review checklist available at the Building Inspection website.

Only a contractor licensed by the State of Texas as a lawn irrigation contractor and registered with the City of Dallas are allowed to perform the work.

HOW LONG DOES IT TAKE TO **OBTAIN A PERMIT?**

Normally, a permit to install a lawn sprinkler system is issued within I to 3 working days.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST TO **OBTAIN A PERMIT?**

Total permit fees is the base permit fee, plus a plan review fee of \$120 and a \$15 backflow prevention filing fee. For the base permit fee, apply Table B of the fee schedule to the project valuation.
