



No. 51 - 2715 Hibernia

Approx. 1890-1900;

Description: Late Victorian planbook, steep hip roof with projecting gable for front room, single pane windows, gable dormer, bullseye trim on gable windows, turned porch posts with simple brackets, transom over front door, simple wide board trim, cornice window heads.

Condition: Excellent - recently restored.



No. 52 - 2711 Hibernia

Approx. 1930 or 1940;

Description: out size bricks, pyramid roof, possibly older house with newer brick, inset porch pipe posts, concrete porch, new windows, exposed rafter ends, deep porch cornice.

Condition: Poor - fair.



No. 53 - 2707 Hibernia

Approx. 1915-25;

Description: Planbook, gable roof, smaller gable porch roof extending from main roof, exposed rafter ends, 1/1 windows, paired front windows, heavy square porch posts, original wood porch.

Condition: Good - new siding.



No. 54 - 2701 Hibernia

Approx. 1890-1900

Description: Late Victorian planbook, combination hip and gable roof, inset 'L' shape porch, Doric porch columns, transom, side and corner lights, cornice window heads, boxed eaves, diamond shingles in gable end.

Condition: Excellent - restored.



No. 55 - 2619 Hibernia

Approx. 1885-90;

Description: Second Empire, 2 story, twin pavilions, central door with transom, mansard roof, shed porch roof with small pediment on center, paired windows on 2nd floor, 1/1 windows, Doric columns, deep cornice, brick piers under columns, lap siding.

Condition: Excellent. Only one in area.





No. 56 - 2615 Hibernia

Approx. 1910-15;

Description: Craftsman - 1 of 3 in row on street, 2 story, central hip roof, hip dormer, hip porch roof with pediment on center, 6/1, 10/1, 9/1 windows, 3 front doors - 2 with transoms, interior chimney, Doric columns, deep layered cornices, wide door and window trim, brick foundation.

Condition: Excellent.



No. 57 - 2609 Hibernia

Approx. 1910-1915;

Description: Craftsman style, gable roof, interior chimney - just off center, flared base, battered porch pier wall, 2 story, wide door and window trim, 6/6 windows, heavy square porch posts and brackets, gable porch roof with trimmed soffit, projecting eaves.

Condition: Excellent - restored.



No. 58 - 2605 Hibernia

Approx. 1900-1910;

Description: Main hip roof, bay pavilion central chimney brick, half porch columns with heavy square porch posts, 2 front doors with transoms, 6/6, 9/1 and 1/1 windows, boxed and extended eaves.

Condition: Excellent - restored.





No. 59 - 2601 Hibernia

Approx. 1900-1910;

Description: Main pyramidal roof, inset front porch, gable porch roof extension, 1/1, 12/1, and 6/1 windows, exposed rafter ends, extended eaves, rear chimney.

Condition: Excellent - restored.



No. 60 - Routh Street

View: Interior of district; facing south on Routh Street at west corner of State Street; building in center background is nearby downtown skyline.
