1. Unless ONLY family members (immediate or related by one generation) are allowed, letting unrelated people to occupy such dwellings will increase the car traffic, parking arrangements and "load" on an infrastructure that is already strained and in need of updating/upgrade. It could also lead to crime once the existing stricter regulations governing a sub-division are expanded/relaxed. 2. The type of dwelling allowed needs to be tightly regulated/ described so it does not overwhelm the neighborhood and infringe on the privacy of the contiguous properties. Such a dwelling needs to "blend in" and be unintrusive from an architectural viewpoint 3. "Rental property" options on otherwise single family dwelling properties have a history of leading to a decline in property values, and, thus, a commenserate decline in property taxes. Do the research. This is a proven fact with lots of data to support it. That would be the "nail in the coffin" for Dallas "proper" and the quality of life of its residents.
