

## HARRY HINES CORRIDOR STUDY

The North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG), in coordination with the City of Dallas, have been developing a master transportation plan for the Harry Hines Corridor from Loop 12/ Northwest Highway to north of Spur 366 (Woodall Rodgers Freeway). The purpose of this study is to help guide future improvements of the roadway by developing a plan to modernize and define the Harry Hines Corridor by improving connectivity, accessibility, and safety. The goal is to provide multimodal transportation options for all users, support existing and future land uses, enhance the environmental quality and definition of the corridor, and incorporate technology.
