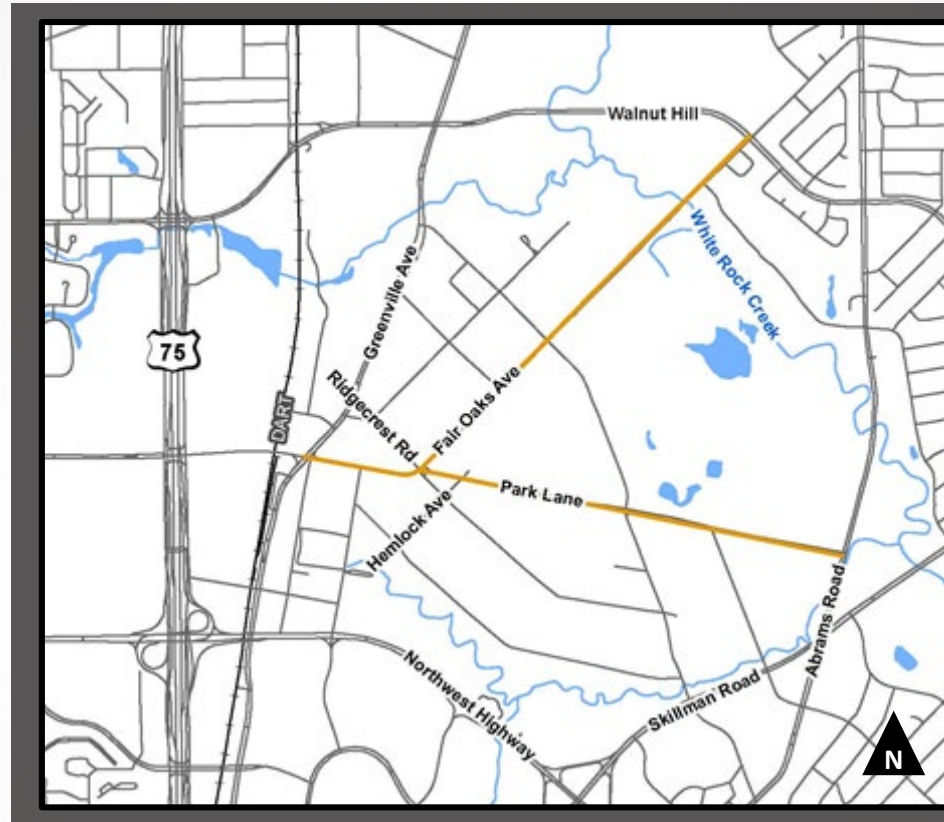
PROJECT OVERVIEW

Limits: From Greenville Avenue to Abram Road and From Ridgcrest Road to Walnut Hill Lane in Dallas County, Texas.

CSJs: CSJ: 0918-47-295, etc.

Description: The project proposes to provide efficient transportation, alleviate congestion, and integrate travel connections for a connected community for safe operations for all users (pedestrians, cyclists, and motorists) which include the corridors for Park Lane from Greenville Avenue to Abrams Road and Fair Oaks Avenue from Ridgcrest Road to Walnut Hill Lane. Improvements include reconfiguration of the “Five Points” intersection; conversion of Fair Oaks Avenue, from a four-lane undivided roadway to a three-lane complete streets corridor with continuous bike facilities and trail connections; and upgraded pedestrian facilities along Park lane.

Right of Way (ROW): The proposed project would, subject to final design considerations, require additional ROW and potential displacements.
