WHAT IS BRANCH OUT DALLAS?

It is estimated that the urban tree canopy averages between 27% and 33% of the total acreage in most U.S. metropolitan and urban areas.

To encourage the planting of new hardwood trees, the annual Branch Out Dallas tree giveaway program gives Dallas homeowners a free, 5-gallon tree to plant in their yard. Go to dallas.gov/branchoutdallas to learn more.

Homeowners who plant trees can benefit from the shade and save energy. Trees help the environment by reducing stormwater runoff to drainage systems, cooling temperatures, improving air quality and mitigating the heat island effect.



Each September, Branch Out Dallas invites residents to sign up for a free tree (while supplies last).

Several varieties are available to choose from. To qualify for a free tree, you must live in the Dallas city limits and have your property's water utilities account number from a recent bill.

Registration opens the first week in September.

The free trees are distributed to registered residents on Dallas Arbor Day, the first Saturday in November. Residents can pick up their tree at one of several convenient sites throughout the city and plant it during the ideal season.
