


## City of Dallas Overall Part 1 Crime Rates 2003 - 2012

The lowest overall Crime Rate since 1966




# **City of Dallas Murder Offense Count 2003-2012**

The lowest Murder Rate since 1958




# City of Dallas Sexual Assault Offense Count 2003-2012




# City of Dallas Aggravated Assault Offense Count 2003-2012

The lowest rate of Aggravated Assault since 1967




# City of Dallas Robbery Offense Count 2003 - 2012




