

An ordinance ordering a general election to be held in the City of Dallas on Saturday, May 4, 2019, for the purpose of electing 15 members to the City Council of the City of Dallas to represent Places 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14 and 15 for the term beginning June 17, 2019 - Financing: No cost consideration to the City

**BACKGROUND**

This item is on the addendum to allow sufficient time to compile information as related to the May 4, 2019 general election.

Chapter III, Section 1, of the City Charter provides for a city council composed of 15 members: a mayor who serves for a term of four years, and 14 council members representing single-member council districts who each serve for terms of two years. The terms of all single district members of the city council expire June 17, 2019.

Chapter IV, Section 3, of the City Charter provides the general election held to elect members of the city council be held on the first authorized election date after March 1 of each odd-numbered year. For 2019, that date is Saturday, May 4, 2019. Section 3.005(c) of the Texas Election Code requires a May election be ordered not later than the 78th day before election day. For the May 4th election, the deadline for ordering the election is Friday, February 15, 2019. Wednesday, February 13, 2019, is the last city council meeting day to order the election without having to schedule a special meeting.

**PRIOR ACTION/REVIEW (COUNCIL, BOARDS, COMMISSIONS)**

ORDINANCE NO. \_\_\_\_\_

An ordinance ordering a general election to be held in the city of Dallas on May 4, 2019, for the purpose of electing 15 members to the city council of the city of Dallas; providing residency requirements for candidates; designating polling places; providing for the use of an electronic voting system for early voting by personal appearance, a computerized voting system for early voting by mail, and electronic and computerized voting systems for voting on election day; permitting only resident qualified voters to vote; providing for early voting; providing for an early voting ballot board to process early voting; providing for notice of the election; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That a general election is ordered to be held in the city of Dallas on Saturday, May 4, 2019, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m., for the purpose of electing 15 members to the city council of the city of Dallas to be designated as Member of Council, Place 15; Member of Council, Place 1; Member of Council, Place 2; Member of Council, Place 3; Member of Council, Place 4; Member of Council, Place 5; Member of Council, Place 6; Member of Council, Place 7; Member of Council, Place 8; Member of Council, Place 9; Member of Council, Place 10; Member of Council, Place 11; Member of Council, Place 12; Member of Council, Place 13; and Member of Council, Place 14. Places 1 through 14 on the city council correspond to those districts as designated on the districting plan adopted by Resolution No. 11-2706 on October 5, 2011.

SECTION 2. That all candidates for member of the Dallas city council must have resided in the city of Dallas for a period of at least six months prior to the date of the election. In addition, each candidate for Member of Council, Place 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, or 14,

shall have resided in District 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, or 14, respectively, for a period of at least six months prior to the date of the election and satisfy any other requirement provided by law.

SECTION 3. That the 15 persons elected as Members of Council, Places 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, and 15, will comprise the city council of the city of Dallas when elected and qualified. The person elected to Place 15 shall be mayor of the city of Dallas.

SECTION 4. That electronic and computerized voting systems must be used for voting on the general election date in compliance with the Texas Election Code, as amended.

SECTION 5. That the manner of conducting the general election must be in accordance with the ordinances and charter of the city of Dallas and the laws of the State of Texas applicable to general elections. The official ballots, together with other election materials required by the Texas Election Code, as amended, must be printed in both English and Spanish and contain all provisions, markings, and language, as may be required by law.

SECTION 6. That the boundaries of the election precincts in which the election is to be held are defined by Ordinance No. 20231, as amended by Ordinance Nos. 20741, 21350, 21579, 22343, 22693, 23348, 24800, 25696, 27484, 28147, 28937, and 29375. Locations of the polling places in the respective election precincts are as designated in **Exhibit A**, attached to this ordinance, but which locations may be changed by Dallas County, and which changes, if any, are hereby made part of this ordinance by reference and can be found by visiting the Dallas County webpage: <<http://www.dallascountyvotes.org/election-day-information/>> or by contacting:

SECTION 7. That each voter must vote in the precinct in which the voter resides, and only resident qualified voters are entitled to vote.

SECTION 8. That a person qualified to vote and residing in the city of Dallas, but not within any precinct described in Ordinance No. 20231, as amended by Ordinance Nos. 20741, 21350, 21579, 22343, 22693, 23348, 24800, 25696, 27484, 28147, 28937, and 29375, may vote in the precinct nearest the person's residence, and for that purpose the person's residence will be considered as part of that city election precinct. A person who has registered in a city election precinct, but whose residence is not in the city of Dallas, is not entitled to vote in the election even though the person may own property subject to taxation in the city.

SECTION 9. That early voting personal appearance by will be by the use of an electronic voting system in accordance with the Texas Election Code, as amended. Early voting by mail will be by the use of a computerized voting system in accordance with the Texas Election Code, as amended. Early voting will be conducted at the locations and during the dates and times established by Dallas County, Texas, as reflected in **Exhibit B**, attached to this ordinance, but which locations may be changed by Dallas County, and which changes, if any, are hereby made part of this ordinance by reference and can be found by visiting the Dallas County webpage: <<http://www.dallascountyvotes.org/early-voting-information/>> or by contacting:

SECTION 12. That the early voting ballots will be processed by an early voting ballot board to be created in accordance with the Texas Election Code, as amended.

SECTION 13. That the mayor or, in the mayor's absence or inability to act, the mayor pro tem, shall give notice of the general election by causing the notice to be published in a newspaper within the city and posted on the city's public meeting bulletin board in accordance with applicable state law.

SECTION 14. That this ordinance will take effect immediately from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the provisions of the Dallas City Charter, and it is accordingly so ordained.

A resolution declaring that *The Confederate Monument* in Pioneer Cemetery is a noncontributing structure for the historic overlay district and authorizing the City Manager to **(1)** take action necessary to secure approval from the Landmark Commission, and any related appeals, if necessary, to remove and store *The Confederate Monument*; **(2)** procure services to disassemble, remove, and transfer to storage *The Confederate Monument* with a vendor selected by the City Manager pursuant to a request for competitive sealed proposals and to enter into a contract, approved as to form by the City Attorney, in an amount not to exceed \$480,000.00; and **(3)** increase appropriations in an amount not to exceed \$480,000.00 in the Office of Cultural Affairs budget from General Fund Contingency Reserve - Not to exceed \$480,000.00 - Financing: Contingency Reserve Funds

**BACKGROUND**

On April 25, 2018, the City Council adopted a resolution directing the City Manager to take certain actions related to Confederate art and symbols. The City Council deferred any disassembly and removal of *The Confederate Monument* until the city manager reviewed other ideas to enhance and improve Pioneer Cemetery, including creating new statues or plaques or other alterations, such as recontextualizing *The Confederate Monument*.

The City Council was subsequently briefed on available options on February 6, 2019. Options included re-envisioning the monument and site, removing the monument, or taking no further action. Based on the City Council's discussion of those options, this action authorizes a resolution declaring that *The Confederate Monument* in Pioneer Cemetery is a noncontributing structure that is newer than the period of historic significance for the historic overlay district, and demolition or removal of the noncontributing structure will not adversely affect the historic character of Pioneer Cemetery or the integrity of the historic overlay district. It further authorizes the City Manager to exhaust all options to obtain the necessary approvals for disassembly, removal, and storage, to procure services to disassemble, remove, and store *The Confederate Monument*, and the use of General Fund contingency funds in an amount not to exceed \$480,000.00 for those contracted services.

The Cultural Affairs Commission was briefed on the Task Force recommendations on October 12, 2017.

The Quality of Life, Arts and Culture Committee was briefed on the Task Force recommendations on October 23, 2017.

City Council received public comments related to the Task Force recommendations on October 25, 2017.

City Council was briefed on the Task Force recommendations on November 1, 2017.

City Council was further briefed on recommendations related to Confederate monuments on March 21, 2018.

On April 25, 2018, City Council adopted Resolution No. 18-0626 directing the City Manager to take certain actions related to Confederate art and symbols; however, City Council deferred any disassembly and removal of *The Confederate Monument* until the city manager reviewed other ideas to enhance and improve Pioneer Cemetery, including creating new statues or plaques or other alterations, such as recontextualizing *The Confederate Monument*.

City Council was briefed on recontextualization options for The Confederate Monument on February 6, 2019.

**BACKGROUND**

This important item is on the addendum to initiate development of the City's Strategic Mobility Plan.

This action will authorize an Advance Funding Agreement with TxDOT to receive Regional Toll Revenue (RTR) funds from the North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG) for development of a strategic mobility plan for the City. On May 10, 2018, the NCTCOG Regional Transportation Council approved the 2019-2022 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The 2019-2022 TIP was approved by the Texas Transportation Commission on September 27, 2018, and it includes a total project cost of \$1,500,000 for the Strategic Mobility Plan. That total project cost is divided into \$1,000,000 in RTR funds, a required local match of \$250,000, and an overmatch of \$250,000. The required local match represents 20 percent of \$1,250,000.

This consultant contract will provide for the development of the City's first ever five-year strategic mobility plan. The consultant will deliver the Strategic Mobility Plan within a 12-month schedule. The term of the consultant contract is 18 months to provide a six-month period for additional studies, early implementation strategies and project close-out activities. The City and partner agencies have

developed many plans and studies that have improved access to multimodal transportation in Dallas. However, the City does not have an established strategic vision for transportation that emphasizes integrated transportation decision-making with housing, economic development, equity, and the environment.

The strategic mobility plan will establish the five-year strategic vision for transportation that will provide the following:

- Establish the driving principles for transportation in Dallas
- Develop baseline data that will inform policy, program, and project investment decisions
- Establish a framework for evaluating the impact of transportation investments driving principles, especially on economic development and housing in Dallas
- Identify a preferred transportation investment strategy for the City supporting the plan's driving economic development decision-making

A five member committee from the following departments reviewed and evaluated the qualifications:

- Department of Transportation (1)
- Department of Planning and Urban Design (1)
- The North Central Texas Council of Governments (1)
- Office of Procurement Services (1)\*
- Office of Business Diversity (1)\*

\*The Office of Procurement Services only evaluated cost and the Office of Business Diversity only evaluated the Business Inclusion and Development Plan.

The committee selected the successful respondent on the basis of demonstrated competence and qualifications under the following criteria:

- Cost 30 points
- Capability/experience 20 points
- Overall approach 35 points
- Business Inclusion Development 15 points

As part of the solicitation process and in an effort to increase competition, the Office of Procurement Services used its procurement system to send out 2,455 email bid notifications to vendors registered under respective commodities. To further increase competition, the Office of Procurement Services uses historical solicitation information, the internet, and vendor contact information obtained from user departments to contact additional vendors by phone. Additionally, in an effort to secure more bids, the Office of Business Diversity sent notifications to 25 chambers of commerce and advocacy groups to ensure maximum vendor outreach.

On November 10, 2015, City Council authorized a living wage policy that requires contractors to pay their employees a "living wage" rate as established annually by the Massachusetts Institute of Technology Living Wage Calculator for Dallas County by Resolution No. 15-2141. The current calculated living wage during the solicitation process of this contract is \$11.15; the selected vendor meets this requirement.

**BACKGROUND**

This item is on the addendum because final pricing was just received from the contractor and to meet the deadline for Summer 2019 pool season.

On November 14, 2018, City Council authorized a contract with Kraftsman, L.P. dba Kraftsman Commercial Playgrounds & Waterparks, through the Texas Association of School Boards, for construction of six spraygrounds at Grauwyler Park located at 7780 Harry Hines Boulevard, Jaycee/Zaragoza Park located at 3114 Clymer Street, Kleberg Park located at 1515 Edd Road, Nash/Davis Park located at 3700 North Hampton Road, K.B. Polk Park located at 3860 Thedford Avenue and Timberglen Park located at 3900 Timberglen Road in an amount not to exceed \$5,920,827.15, by Resolution No. 18-1622.

This action will authorize Change Order No. 1 to the construction services contract with Kraftsman, L.P. dba Kraftsman Commercial Playgrounds & Waterparks for an increase in the contract to include modifications to the pumps and filtration equipment to achieve future reductions in operating and maintenance costs; additional subsurface preparation at Kleberg Park, Nash/Davis Park and Timberglen Park required by findings of the geotechnical and environmental reports; changes due to code requirements and other refinements to the design, in an amount not to exceed \$760,943.40,

increasing the contract amount from \$5,920,827.15 to \$6,681,770.55. The additional cost per sprayground is as follows:

The original schedule for design and construction was expedited in order to open the six spraygrounds for the Summer 2019 pool season instead of 2020. To meet the completion date, Kraftsman was engaged, under a cooperative agreement, and provided the construction pricing at the end of the Design Development Phase instead at the completion of construction documents, so the contract could be approved by the City Council in November. After the completion of the Design Development Phase and pricing was provided, further refinements were required to the design based on the geotechnical and environmental reports; maintenance staff recommendations for improvements to the filtration, pump and drainage systems; and code review comments. A project contingency for each sprayground was originally set aside to address extra costs, so the spraygrounds are still within budget.

Improvements to pump, filtration, vault, controls, and drainage system will save on operation and maintenance costs estimated at \$93,174.00 per year for the six spraygrounds. Additionally, the improved filtration systems will reduce the number of times the spraygrounds are closed for maintenance due to foreign objects such as balloons, leaves and litter clogging the system, thereby improving the quality of customer experience. The modified equipment will also reduce maintenance trips and the wear and tear to the pump systems.

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**SUBJECT**

A resolution rescinding Resolution No. 78-0309, previously approved on February 1, 1978, which provided for radio coverage of City Council meetings on WRR-FM, to discontinue City Council meeting broadcasts on WRR-FM - Estimated Annual Revenue: \$80,000.00 (see Fiscal Information for potential future costs)

**BACKGROUND**

WRR-FM Radio, a division of the Office of Cultural Affairs, has been broadcasting classical music since 1964. Out of 67 major stations in the Dallas-Fort Worth market, it is the only station broadcasting classical music. As an enterprise fund in the City's budget, WRR supports itself solely through the sale of advertising. The station has made significant improvements in ratings and listenership over the past four years by reducing the amount of talk on the station by:

- eliminating news and weather reports;
- training announcers to be concise and direct;
- cutting the number of commercial breaks in half; and
- eliminating all talk programs except paid programs on Saturday and Sunday mornings.

Even though the number of commercial breaks has been reduced, revenue has remained steady as the station has been able to raise its ad rates due to corresponding increases in listenership and ratings. To help continue this growth in listenership this action will discontinue City Council Agenda Meeting broadcasts which began in 1978 at the direction of the City Council.

Nielsen radio audience measurement data has shown that WRR's audience numbers decrease during the broadcast of City Council Agenda Meetings. During the May - July 2018 quarter, the WRR listening audience decreased by 82 percent during the broadcast, with the average quarter-hour audience (number of individuals tuned in per 15-minute period) dropping from approximately 10,600 to 1,900 listeners.

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Public access to the City's open meetings has been enhanced in recent years. Dallas residents can view both live and archived City Council briefing, agenda and committee meetings, as well as board and commission meetings, online at DallasCityHall.com. Additionally, these meetings are also on Spectrum Channel 95, ATT U-verse Channel 99 and Verizon FIOS Channel 47.

Additionally, live-audio online streaming of open meetings was added to the City's website in January 2019 at the request of the Quality of Life, Arts and Culture Committee.

Freeing up the Wednesday blocks of programming will allow WRR to return to regular classical programming, which will lead to increased listenership, increased ratings, and finally, increased revenue for the station.

Staff proposes to consider this alternative during budget development for FY 2019-20.
