Anyone wishing to speak at a meeting should sign up with the City Secretary's Office by calling (214) 670-3738 before 9:00 a.m. on the meeting date. Citizens can find out the name of their representative and their voting district by calling the City Secretary's Office.

Sign interpreters are available upon request with a 48-hour advance notice by calling (214) 670-5208 V/TDD. The City of Dallas is committed to compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act. <u>The Council agenda is available in alternative formats upon request</u>.

Rules of Courtesy

City Council meetings bring together citizens of many varied interests and ideas. To insure fairness and orderly meetings, the Council has adopted rules of courtesy which apply to all members of the Council, administrative staff, news media, citizens and visitors. These procedures provide:

- That no one shall delay or interrupt the proceedings, or refuse to obey the orders of the presiding officer.
- All persons should refrain from private conversation, eating, drinking and smoking while in the Council Chamber.
- Posters or placards must remain outside the Council Chamber.
- No cellular phones or audible beepers allowed in Council Chamber while City Council is in session.

"Citizens and other visitors attending City Council meetings shall observe the same rules of propriety, decorum and good conduct applicable to members of the City Council. Any person making personal, impertinent, profane or slanderous remarks or who becomes boisterous while addressing the City Council or while attending the City Council meeting shall be removed from the room if the sergeant-at-arms is so directed by the presiding officer, and the person shall be barred from further audience before the City Council during that session of the City Council. If the presiding officer fails to act, any member of the City Council may move to require enforcement of the rules, and the affirmative vote of a majority of the City Council shall require the presiding officer to act." Section 3.3(c) of the City Council Rules of Procedure.

Authorize (1) a thirty-six-month lease agreement for City of Dallas south properties (list attached) with XTO Energy, Inc., in the amount of \$14,380,867 and a 26% royalty on hydrocarbons produced, (2) a thirty-six-month lease agreement, with one thirty-six-month renewal option, for City of Dallas north/Trinity River properties (list attached) with Trinity East Energy, LLC, in the amount of \$19,045,376 and a 25% royalty on hydrocarbons produced, and (3) a thirty-six-month lease agreement, with one thirty-six-month renewal option, for City of Dallas Love Field properties (list attached) with Trinity East Energy, LLC, in the amount of \$1,455,072 and a 15% royalty on hydrocarbons produced for natural gas drilling and production lease rights, most advantageous proposers of two - Estimated Revenue \$34,881,315

BACKGROUND

The City issued a Request for Proposal (RFP) in July of 2007 for companies interested in leasing City owned property for natural gas drilling and production. The RFP included City owned properties located on the western edge of the City and within the Barnett Shale area. The City unbundled the lease properties into the following groups:

- Group 1 Dallas North Properties 2031.11 acres
- Group 2 Dallas South Properties 1536.91 acres
- Group 2A Trinity River 1613.48 acres
- Group 3 Dallas Love Field 1322.79 acres
- Group 4 Dallas Executive Airport 1176.32 acres

BACKGROUND (Continued)

July 20, 2007 the RFP was published on the City's procurement website and e-mail notifications were sent to all vendors registered under commodities related to oil and gas. Phone calls were then made to the State's top 30 gas production companies as well as additional companies solicited by other Cities and/or participated in lease solicitations, and on July 26-27, 2007 another phone call was made to targeted companies.

The RFP established a Minimum Bid:

- A minimum lease bonus of \$4,000 per acre and 25% royalty was established for the North, South, and Trinity River Properties
- No minimum bid for the airport properties was set due to their location on the far eastern boundary of the Barnett Shale

The City also engaged outside counsel, Moses, Palmer, & Howell, L.L.P., to review and advise on all aspects of gas drilling and production in the City, including the ordinance, RFP documents, lease agreement, and lease negotiation.

Proposals were received on November 9, 2007 with Trinity East Energy, LLC. proposing on all groups except Dallas Executive Airport, and XTO Energy, Inc. proposing on only the Dallas South properties. Subsequently, a request for a best and final offer from both proposers on the South properties yielded an increase in both offers, with the highest proposal from XTO Energy, Inc.

As part of the bid process, 656 vendor notices were sent electronically by the City's web based procurement system. In an effort to secure more bids, notifications were sent by the Business Development and Procurement Services' ResourceLINK Team (RLT) to 25 chambers of commerce, and two advocacy groups (i.e. DFW Minority Business Council and Women's Business Council – Southwest).



BACKGROUND

On January 23, 2008, the City Council adopted the recommendation of the City Council's Finance, Audit & Accountability Committee, and approved reduced rates for Atmos Gas Corporation's Mid-Tex Division for residential, commercial, and industrial customers in the City. Atmos has advised staff that it will appeal from that action to the Railroad Commission. Staff also has learned that the Railroad Commission will consolidate that appeal with an already-pending rate case at the Commission (GUD No. 9762) wherein Atmos is seeking gas distribution rate increases for unincorporated areas in North Texas and for cities that have ceded their rate regulatory jurisdiction to the Commission. Such a proceeding is termed an "environs case." The environs case has been pending since October 26, 2007.

Since late October, staff had been actively discussing settlement with Atmos respecting the company's pending Dallas rate case. When it began to appear that settlement would not occur before the January 23, 2008, statutory deadline for the City Council to act on Atmos' Dallas rate filing, and that the City Council would set rates on January 23 that Atmos would appeal, and because certain findings and actions taken in the environs case could be used against the City, the City Attorney's Office authorized outside counsel (Mounce, Green, Myers, Safi, Paxson & Galatzan, P.C.) to intervene in the environs case. This early intervention was necessary because substantive hearings in the environs case were already scheduled for February 11, 2008.

BACKGROUND (continued)

Thus, for outside counsel to research, analyze, and argue Atmos' novel rate design theories, participate in depositions of experts, Atmos executives, and others, and prepare for the upcoming hearings, the firm had to commence work immediately.

PRIOR ACTION/REVIEW (Council, Boards, Commissions)

On January 14, 2008, the City Council's Finance, Audit & Accountability Committee was briefed on Atmos' Statement of Intent to increase Dallas natural gas distribution rates and of the City's consultant's recommendations to deny that rate increase and to approve reduced rates. On January 23, 2008, the City Council approved rates for Atmos Gas Corporation's Mid-Tex Division for City residential, commercial, and industrial customers.

BACKGROUND

On September 20, 2007, Atmos Energy Corp., Mid-Tex Division (Atmos) filed with the City of Dallas (City) its "Statement of Intent to Increase Utility Rates in the Atmos Energy Corp. Mid-Tex Division Gas Utility System." Staff has reviewed the filing and determined that it is necessary to retain outside consultants with expertise in gas regulation issues to assist in reviewing the filing.

Diversified Utility Consultants, Inc. (DUCI) has expertise in gas regulatory matters and is currently assisting the City with gas related issues before the Railroad Commission of Texas and in state district court.

Atmos made this Show Cause Filing in manner that purports to be consistent with its prior City of Dallas Rate case which was litigated before the Railroad Commission and is now currently on appeal in State District Court. Because DUCI has intimate knowledge of that prior case and is currently assisting the City with its appeal, staff solicited a proposal from DUCI to review the current Filing.

The City adopted an Ordinance on January 23, 2008 which denied the rate request and ordered Atmos to lower its rates within the City of Dallas. Atmos has appealed that rate Ordinance to the Railroad Commission of Texas. This Supplemental Agreement is required so that DUCI can prepare testimony and assist the City in its appeal of the municipal rate order before the Railroad Commission of Texas.

WHEREAS, Atmos Energy Corp., Mid-Tex Division filed its "Statement of Intent to Increase Utility Rates in the Atmos Energy Corp., Mid-Tex Division Gas Utility System" on September 20, 2007; and

WHEREAS, Diversified Utility Consultants, Inc. is currently assisting the City of Dallas with matters pertaining to the rates charged by Atmos Energy Corp. at the Railroad Commission of Texas and in State District Court; and

WHEREAS, Diversified Utility Consultants, Inc. has expertise in gas regulatory matters and gas utility cost of service; and

WHEREAS, Diversified Utility Consultants, Inc. submitted a proposal to assist the City in its review of the current "Statement of Intent to Increase Utility Rates"; and

WHEREAS, Diversified Utility Consultants, Inc. submitted a report detailing findings pertaining to the "Statement of Intent to Increase Utility Rates" to the City on January 16, 2008; and

WHEREAS, Diversified Utility Consultants, Inc. in its report, made recommendations pertaining to fair and reasonable rates to be charged by Atmos; and

WHEREAS, the City on January 23, 2008 adopted Ordinance No. 27070 setting rates to be charged by Atmos Energy Corp. as recommended by Diversified Utility Consultants, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, Atmos Energy Corp., Mid-Tex Division has appealed the City's rate Order to the Railroad Commission of Texas; and

WHEREAS, the expert consulting services and testimony of Diversified Utility Consultants, Inc. are necessary in this matter;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That following approval as to form by the City Attorney, the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into Supplemental Agreement No. 1 to the professional services contract with Diversified Utility Consultants, Inc., for additional expert consulting services and testimony necessary in Matters Related to the Dallas Show Cause Filing, in an amount not to exceed \$90,000, increasing the contract amount from \$70,000 to \$160,000.

SECTION 2. That the City Controller is authorized to disburse, in periodic payments to Diversified Utility Consultants, Inc., an amount not to exceed \$90,000 from Fund 0001, Dept. BMS, Unit 1246, Obj. 3070, Encumbrance No. BMS1246D8038, Vendor No. 249678.

SECTION 3. That the City Controller is authorized to deposit reimbursement revenue received from Atmos Energy Corporation to Fund 0001, Dept. BMS, Unit 1246, Revenue Code 7501.

SECTION 4. That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so resolved.
