

THE LOOP

The Circuit Trail Conservancy (CTC) is a non-profit, public private partnership with the City of Dallas building The LOOP, a premier urban active trail network around the core of Dallas connecting neighborhoods to transportation hubs and economic opportunity. The Trinity Forest Spine Trail is a critical component of The LOOP, a 9-mile connection from White Rock Lake through the Trinity Forest to the AT&T Trail.




