### **Addendum Item # 2 & 3 Landscape Maintenance Agreement with the Department of Transportation** (TxDOT) for landscape improvements along US75

On June 15, 2016, your addendum agenda will include a request authorization for:

(1) a renewal amendment to the Municipal Maintenance Interlocal Agreement (MMA) with the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) to authorize the City to continue to mow, clean, and control litter on state highway rights-of way for an additional five years; and

(2) a request authorization for a Landscape Maintenance Agreement (LMA) with TxDOT for the City to maintain the median, planters and bridge crossings related to TxDOT recommendation for landscape improvements of succulent plantings along US 75 from Spur 366 (Woodall Rodgers Freeway) to IH 635 within Texas Department of Transportation rights-of-way.

### (1) MMA

The original MMA formalized the relationship between TXDOT and the City related to all aspects of maintenance on TxDOT properties within the City limits. This amendment to the existing MMA allows the City to continue to provide enhanced maintenance services along 17 TxDOT corridors for no less than five (5) years and allows the City to receive reimbursements totaling \$871K annually.

### <u>(2) LMA</u>

Under the LMA program, TxDOT agrees to design and install landscaping on TxDOT property and the City agrees to provide maintenance, once the responsibility is turned over. Currently the City has two LMA's for the US75 project; one for the median and planters and one for bridge crossings. The proposed LMA will condense these two agreements into one new LMA for the US75 project.

Previous provisions for the landscaping and amenities package along North Central Expressway (US75) were accepted by the City Council in 1986. In that package, TxDOT and the City agreed to each pay half of the \$10.1 million amenities package which included landscaping. The vegetation planted did not survive. As a result, TxDOT began removing the vegetation. Discussions with TxDOT began in early 2008 in order to slow or halt the removals, and several options were discussed. In 2010 the City agreed to work with TxDOT to advance the Native Grass Program. Native grasses are currently installed along US75. Citizen feedback indicated that the native grasses are not aesthetically pleasing and have not held up as well during drought conditions. The City and State recognized the need to address this issue.

TxDOT recommended succulents which are more drought tolerant and aesthetically pleasing, and require no irrigation system. The proposed vegetation will consist of approximately 36,000 plants of which include several varieties of Yucca (red, white, yellow and pink blooms) and Sotol. TxDOT will fund approximately \$840K for the succulent installation. In turn, the City would agree to be responsible for all required landscape maintenance including but not limited to plant maintenance, plant replacement, weeding, trimming, and manual watering, as required, once the City takes over maintenance responsibility from TxDOT during FY2018. The typical annualized maintenance cost to City would be \$704,060 which includes the incremental future cost for the succulent maintenance of \$232,180 annually.

### **Committee Action**

On January 11, 2016, the Quality of Life Committee endorsed this succulent option and moved the item forward for full Council consideration. <u>Should the Council elect not to move forward with an enhanced alternative planting, the City would continue with the maintenance of the Native Grass Program until the terms of the existing LMA's run out.</u> The LMA for the US 75 median and side planters and terminates April 24, 2017. LMA 2 for the expressway bridges from US 75 from Woodall Rodgers Freeway to IH 635 (with the exception of the bridges at Mockingbird Lane, SMU Blvd. Lovers Lane and Southwestern Blvd that are maintained by University Park) terminates in January 2018.

The proposed LMA would include the scope of work of the two current LMAs and has no specified contract term. As stated in the termination clause of the agreement, it is understood and agreed between the parties hereto that should either party fail to properly fulfill its obligations as herein outlined, the other party may terminate this agreement upon thirty days written notice. Additionally, this agreement may be terminated by mutual agreement and consent of both parties.

This summer 20 Dallas Public Library branches are providing free summer lunches and snacks to children and teens. Thanks to an Americorps grant received by our partner, the nonprofit hunger organization Equal Heart, the library is able to expand service from last year with help from Americorps members who help serve the boxed lunches at most of the sites. The meals are funded by the Texas Department of Agriculture's Summer Food Service Program.

No proof of need or pre-registration is required to receive the meals. The free lunch program will continue through Aug. 19. Lunch and snack times are coordinated with library programs and community activities.

Dallas Public Library Summer Meal Service and Educational Opportunities for Children June 10, 2016

Last summer, the Library served 14,750 lunches and 22,837 snacks at 11 locations. Eight branches continued meal service during the school year as afterschool "super snacks." Nearly 9,000 afterschool meals were served in conjunction with enrichment programming.

Summer lunches are just one way the Library supports students in their out-of-school time. For the second year, the Library is partnering with Dallas ISD to implement the Summer Book Buddies tutoring program at 13 locations. Library staff and volunteers will lead students in group reading exercises and one-on-one practice using DISD's Tutoring Toolkits. DISD purchased the kits specifically for the libraries to use with DISD students. In addition, several Dallas Park and Recreation Centers expressed interest in making reading tutoring part of their summer camps. Center staff were invited to attend Library-staff-led training on using the toolkits and group games.

Thanks to a grant from The Dallas Foundation, the Library offers a slate of STEAM activities at all locations. This summer, the STEAM programs include making robots that draw, visualizing Pi using art and blocks, experimenting with Archimedes screw, and creating 3D illustrations, to name a few of the inventive but simple ways librarians help keep students' minds sharp over the summer.

- SUBJECT Follow-up on Fiscal Year 2015 Single Audit for Continuum of Care Grants

On June 6, 2016, Grant Thornton, LLP presented the Budget, Finance, and Audit Committee with the results of the Fiscal Year 2015 Audit. The report included two findings related to the Housing/Community Services Department's Continuum of Care (CoC) program. The CoC are competitive grants from HUD that allow the City to provide housing assistance and supportive services to homeless individuals and families. The FY 2015 awards totaled \$2.6 million.

The auditor noted that certain forms for Reasonable Rental Rate determination and Housing Quality Standard inspection were missing for two files. In response to the auditor's findings, the Housing/Community Services Department has revised its policies and procedures to require program managers to review and verify all participant files to ensure their accuracy and completeness prior to providing any assistance to the client.

A review of the sequence of events and findings for the May 2 animal attack on Antoinette Brown is attached for your review.

A dozen gaps and opportunities (noted in bolded text) have been identified and are implemented or will be implemented through the partnership that has embedded a Dallas Police Department team into Dallas Animal Services to help improve communication and the City's focus on loose dogs and animal-related attacks and injuries.

Additional staffing for on-duty animal service officers during deep nights may be considered during the FY16-17 budget development process.

### 9-1-1/3-1-1 Animal-Related Call History Involving 3307 Spring Ave.

- 9-1-1: From July 2013 to April 2016, 9-1-1 received 1 animal-related call involving 3307 Spring.
  - September 11, 2015: 9-1-1 hang up call received at 9:01 am from 3235 Spring Ave. Patrol officers arrived at 9:04 am. Dallas Police Department (DPD) Officers at the scene observed several pit bulls loose in the area. The call was signal was changed to an animal disturbance and Dallas Animal Services (DAS) was notified via 3-1-1 dispatch, responded, and took enforcement action (Service Request (SR) #15-00420770).
- **3-1-1**: From July 2013 to April 2016, 3-1-1 received 11 calls pertaining to animals. During this time period, DAS had the following interactions with the residents:
  - September 14, 2013: Residents surrendered 6 puppies.
  - o January 19, 2014: Residents surrendered 2 dogs.
  - Between January 11, 2014 and April 11, 2014, a warning notice and 2 violation notices were issued on calls for "Loose Aggressive" animals.
  - May 17, 2014: Residents surrendered 2 dogs.
  - June 29, 2014: Residents surrendered 6 puppies.
  - August 22, 2014: A verbal warning was issued for "Loose Aggressive" animal.
  - May 13, 2015: Residents surrendered 2 dogs.
  - September 11, 2015: In response to a 9-1-1 call, DPD responded and requested assistance from DAS for an animal disturbance (15-00420770).
    - DAS issued five citations and took custody of 3 dogs through owner surrender.
  - Opportunity: Increased priority of warrants served by Dallas Marshal's Office (DMO) for animal violations.
    - Since May, DMO has arrested 40 individuals with 159 animal related warrants and continue to focus enforcement in priority areas. From January through April, 17 subjects had been arrested and 69 cases cleared.
  - Opportunity: "Flag/link" high-priority cases and/or areas to alert responding animal service officer (ASO), coordinate multidepartment response to public safety issues.

### May 2016 Events

### Rutledge St./S Trunk Ave. May 2, 2016

4:42 a.m.

- 9-1-1 received a call (from 3326 Rutledge Jackie Humphrey) about a female begging for someone to help her.
- DPD arrived at 4:50 a.m. and requested Dallas Fire-Rescue (DFR) response for injured person.
- DFR arrived 5:03 a.m. and made patient contact at 5:04 a.m.
- Departed with victim at 5:10 a.m. to Baylor Hospital with lights/sirens (priority 1 code 3) and arrived at 5:17 a.m.
- DPD officers compiled an injured person's report and left the scene.
- No dogs were observed in the area by DPD.

• Opportunity: DPD responds as a priority 1 to all animal attack in progress calls to 9-1-1. DAS assist now required on all calls referencing animal attacks with serious bodily injury and/or bites with animals still at large.

  - Mentioned that dogs chased him.
  - Attempts to lead DPD and DFR to location. DPD and DFR were already on location.

#### 1:30 p.m.

• DPD detectives went to the hospital and learned from the medical staff that victim was in critical condition

### 2:30 p.m.

• DPD detectives began canvassing area and collecting information. Detectives responded to 3307 Spring Avenue. No one came to the door, no sign of dogs at the location.

#### 11:23 p.m.

- 3-1-1 received a call indicating the dogs that had committed an attack were in the owner's backyard. The call was entered as a "Loose Owned" request by the 3-1-1 agent, SR# 16-00195138, and went into the DAS response queue based on priority for Loosed Owned SR type.
- The case was dispatched to DAS the following day at 7:50 a.m. based on the call type priority.
- Opportunity: Caller referenced a recent attack and the case could have been escalated for ASO dispatch. As stated earlier, "Flag/link" high-priority cases and/or areas to alert responding ASO, coordinate multidepartment response to public safety issues.
- Opportunity: Take home vehicles have been approved for on-call DAS officers to improve response.
- Opportunity: Add additional ASO to provide extended coverage for expedited response to priority calls during the deep night hours.

#### May 3, 2016

#### 9:03 a.m.

• DAS worked SR# 16-00195138 for the "Loose Owned" call, patrolled the area and saw no loose dogs.

#### 8:37 p.m.

- Resident called 9-1-1 to report loose dogs on Rutledge St. Three black and brown dogs.
- 9-1-1 operator called 3-1-1 and call agent created an "Animal-Urgent Assist" SR# 16-00197775 on 3319 Rutledge St.

#### 9:51 p.m.

• Two DAS officers arrived to assist DPD per SR# 16-00197775. DPD had already been on scene and left after no loose dogs were found. DAS officers left approximately one hour later after no dogs were seen.

• Opportunity: Add DAS to Computer-Aided Dispatch and radio system used by 9-1-1 for DPD and DFR. Ensure exchange or hand-off of contact information.

### <u>May 4, 2016</u>

#### 3:44 a.m.

- Citizen calls 9-1-1 and operator contacts 3-1-1 dispatch at 3:47 am. Animal "Attack in Progress" (SR# 16-00197920) at Rutledge St. and S. Trunk (Rev. Spencer, being attacked by 3 pit bulls, running after him, did not bite). DPD was dispatched and arrived 4:04 am and indicated complainant said animals charged but did not bite, same dogs that have attacked people in the area, no dog sighting.
- 3-1-1 Dispatch contacts on-call ASO at 3:50 a.m. but the ASO missed the call. At 4:45 a.m. the ASO returns the call to 3-1-1 Dispatch. 3-1-1 told ASO no need to respond because DPD saw no dogs.
- Gap: DAS policy requires escalation to supervisor when on-call ASO does not respond within 15 minutes.
- Opportunity: As stated above, add overnight DAS coverage for improved response.
- Opportunity: Assign resource to monitor calls and ensure priority calls are categorized appropriately.

#### 8:12 am

• 3-1-1 Dispatch date/time in Chameleon for SR# 16-00197920. Because DPD hadn't seen any dogs overnight and the ASO didn't need to respond overnight, the 3-1-1 dispatcher didn't put the call into DAS' dispatch queue until normal business hours.

#### 9:15 am

• DAS arrives on-scene, checked the area, saw no loose or attacking dogs at this time. Closed case, unable to locate, at 9:20 am.

- 3-1-1 caller says there was a bite on Monday and the dogs from 3307 Spring Avenue are in the backyard of the property again, and suspects that owners are hiding the animals inside the home. 3-1-1 cannot locate bite record for the location, so a new bite service request is created, SR# 16-00200003.

- As follow-up to the bite call on the prior day, DAS returns to 3307 Spring Ave and left a quarantine notice to surrender animals as a result of citizens' tips. Resident not home.
- DAS begins contacting neighbors and hospitals to find possible victim(s) and any additional information to identify dogs and victim.

#### May 6, 2016

- About 1 p.m., DAS meets DPD at 3307 Spring Ave. and note 8 dogs on the property. Six dogs were impounded; one was left with resident that did not match the description of the attacking dogs and one escaped. DAS issues nine citations.
- At 10 p.m., DPD met with both original callers to 9-1-1. Second caller did not observe the attack but did see the dogs running towards Spring Avenue after the attack.

#### <u>May 7, 2016</u>

• DAS officers contacted the resident for the dog that was still at-large. Resident was given a citation for failure to quarantine. DAS officers went door-to-door and patrolled neighborhood, and again on Sunday, May 8.

#### <u>May 9, 2016</u>

- DAS vehicle on patrol in the area captured the seventh dog at 3307 Spring Avenue.
- DAS serves a Serious Bodily injury warrant to the residents of 3307 Spring Avenue.

#### <u>May 15, 2016</u>

- Serious bodily injury hearing is canceled when resident at 3307 Spring Avenue surrendered ownership of the animals in custody of DAS to the City.
- Through May 31, sustained DAS patrols of the neighborhood impounded 17 additional dogs and issued 26 citations in the Rutledge Street area.

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



911: No, he doesn't have a good phone, he's on the phone, hello? But it's a disconnected phone he's calling from

311: Oh, ok, alright thank you

911: Alright, thanks

311: Bye

911: Hello?

### May 4, 2016 3:50 a.m.

This call / recording is our Animal Services dispatcher making a call and leaving a message for the on call Animal Services Officer. It was made on May 4th at 3:50 am and lasted 51 seconds.

311: This is Glenda, there is an attack in progress 911 has an open line with the person yelling that someone is being attacked by a pit bull and two police officers are already in the way to Rutledge and Trunk, Its uh 3:50.

### May 4, 2016 4:06 a.m.

This call / recording is from the DPD officer on the scene at Rutledge and Spring who is calling into the Animal Services dispatcher to update her on the call. It was made on May 4th at 4:06 am and lasted 4 minutes and 22 seconds. On this call it is mentioned that the Animal Services on call person is yet to respond to the page as of some 15 minutes after the page was sent out.

### 311: Dispatch, Glenda

DPD: Yes, this is Officer Sanchez of the Dallas Police Department, and I was calling because there is an animal disturbance here at uh, I'm at uh, 3300 of Rutledge St. and Trunk in South Dallas, so the guy didn't get attacked, I mean he did get attacked, he wasn't bit, but it's the same dogs, I don't know if um ya'll were advised, maybe about two days ago, like the exact same place and the exact same dogs.

311: and they were there, yeah they were there earlier this um, before I came in last night, they were there too.

DPD: Well, these dogs, I don't know if you heard about this but, about two nights ago, the night that it was raining, they attacked a lady and literally they almost killed her. And the bicep was missing, chunks, and I'm going uh, I've seen a lot of dog bites, but these...I've never seen anything like this. She looked like she was attacked by a shark. There's chunks of meat that were off. I mean like her left leg, we had her, she had to be transported to Baylor hospital and she was in a state of shock. I...(unintelligible) I don't even know if she made it. This, this is the type that's that bad.

### 311: Are the dogs confined in some way?

DPD: No we got here, we saw dogs, but, but, it's like an abandoned house and this like happened in the exact same location. So these dogs must live around here or they must be strays. I'm not sure, we asked the neighbors, and they told us they might be staying at the house behind (unintelligible) we went there and talked to the owner and they were like , no, no, there's no dogs that live here (unintelligible) they have a beware of dogs sign but she says that is just to scare away burglars and they don't have evidence of even owning dogs, we went and checked so it wasn't from them. And they, and they told us that they did have a dog but those same pit bulls killed his dog.

### 311: Mm, ok

DPD: So it's two pit bulls, and these, I mean, and then they there about last week about two blocks down, there's a guy, I responded to a guy that was actually bit and I did an injured persons report, uh he was actually bit, but his bite was just, I mean I could see the two, uh bite marks, but it was nothing life threatening or anything uh so these dogs I mean, I don't know what can be done about them, something needs to be done about these dogs.

311: Yeah, it sounds like they need to set traps or something, um...

DPD: Yeah, these are very, very dangerous dogs.

311: Right, so we don't have anybody in Animal control overnight and I had to call him in and I left voicemail and he hasn't returned my call.

DPD: um ok

311: but, he by himself probably couldn't do anything anyway, they're gonna [sic] probably have to set traps, would you want me to put your name and phone number on this call?

DPD: yeah, yeah, you could do that.

311: Ok, what's your name?

DPD: My name is Officer Sanchez

311: and Officer Sanchez its 469.767.5355?

DPD: Yeah, that's my special cell phone.

311: Is that ok if they call you on that?

DPD: yeah, yeah, yeah, they can call me on this number.

311: Ok, I'm going to put this information there and tell then, when they come in at 7, sounds like they are going to have to set traps out there

DPD: Yeah, I think they live at this location so I'll be (unintelligible) like the one from two nights ago was like literally it was right here, and then you say there was one this morning and now here and the guy, (unintelligible) and I tell the guy here because he lives in the (unintelligible) house. I was telling him he was very lucky because uh those dogs uh he said that they were like attacking him but he had a stick, and he was just kinda [sic] like keeping them away and they kept on attacking so he had to run inside and um. So we when we got here we saw the two dogs. They are two pit bulls.

311: What color were they by the way?

DPD: (did you see the color?) ne of them was brown, like brownish, reddish color, the other one was right behind him but it's the same dogs because its two pit bulls that are doing this.

311: Ok, I will put all this on there and I guess if they have any questions, they will call you.

DPD: ok

311: Alright, thank you.

DPD: No problem, thank you ma'am

311: Bye bye

DPD: Bye

Caller: I'm sorry, who is this?

311: It's on Rutledge and um, let's see, I don't remember the other street. Hold on. Rutledge and Trunk St.

ACO: Rutledge and Trunk St.?

311: Yeah, Rutledge and Trunk.

ACO: Ok, ah, you said it was in the system right?

311: Yeah, I put it in the system and I typed notes on there about what the police officer said and he even said that someone could call him and he'll explain the situation if they need to but there is nothing you could of done so I didn't call you back.

The call taker researched for a bite call regarding the location but could NOT find an entry, so they began a bite card for the location on Spring / Rutledge.

311: Thank you for calling City of Dallas 311, my name is Ian, how may I help you?

Caller: The pound patch me through, I was supposed to be talking to someone about giving an address where some dogs ate up a lady.

311: Ok, so you mean some dogs attacked a lady?

Caller: Yes, on (unintelligible) St. here in South Dallas

311: Ok, is it happening right now or just happened?

Caller: No, it happened Monday um between 2 in the morning and 4 in the morning.

311: Ok, so someone was bit by the dogs?

Caller: Yeah, they think she in the hospital and she [sic] still fighting for her life. I don't know, the pound lady told me she was dispatching me to one of her officers, so they can come and get the dog, so I don't know how she put me back to 311.

311: Well, what I can do is report the bite incident, but are you wanting to get the dogs collected?

Caller: Yeah

311: Ok

Caller: She told me that you were going to transfer me to someone that would be back

311: Um, are the dogs loose or do they belong to someone there?

Caller: Yeah, they belong to someone there, but they are in a fence, but they get out and attack people.

311: Ok

Caller: They attacked a lady Monday morning and they almost killed her. She's still in the hospital

311: Goodness, ok

Caller: So, um I don't know what they gone do, they need to get those dogs; sometimes they take them in the house, you know they obviously hiding them right now, but I seen [sic] them in the back yard here a few minutes ago, now I don't see them. Maybe they just put them in the house.

311: What I can do is report the bite and put in a request for, to send an animals officer to investigate the attack. And what they would do, they would then proceed from there.

Caller: I think they already have it um reported because um, she's in the hospital behind it. So I don't know...

311: Do you have the address of the owner of the dogs?

Caller: Yes, its 3307 Spring St. It was a big brown one and a big black one and those dogs are always getting out and trying to attack people. Like I said, my mother has called on them on numerous occasions, but for some reason, I don't know what they do to keep them dogs, but someone needs to get them dogs or they are going to kill somebody. This lady that's in the hospital, I don't even know if she is going to die or not because her neighbor told me that she is still fighting for her life.

311: Wow, ok

Caller: So yeah, I don't know.

311: So this is at 3307 spring Ave?

Caller: Yeah, I think its spring St. It's in South Dallas, right off of 2<sup>nd</sup> and Robert B. Cullum, right in that area right there. Spring St. is what I think it is.

311: Yeah, like one over from Pine?

Caller: Yeah, yeah, that one.

311: Ok I was looking up right. I don't show an animal Bite service card for us put in yet. If you have all that information I can go ahead and put it in now.

Caller: Ok, what information do you need?

311: do you know the name of the dog's owner?

Caller: I don't know anything about these people, that's what I'm saying, they dogs just get out and attack folks so they probably attacked her, then they got away. And then when somebody finally call the police, I don't know if the police reported it to the pound or not, but it happened Monday morning. I figure they should already have it annotated. But I don't know what's going on. I just know where the dogs are and those people need to come and get them. Sometimes I even see them out running across the street, running back to the house, not only when I go that way when I see them out there.

311: Right. You said this happened Monday Morning?

Caller: Yes between 2 and 4 in the morning.

311: And the person that was attacked, was that person over 18?

Caller: Yeah, Yeah it was a grown woman.

311: OK

Caller: (I don't know what hospital she in)

311: Do you know the breed of the dogs that attacked her?

Caller: I know one is a pit, but I don't know what that other one is. The other one kind of looks like a Rott but it could be something. It could be a Rott mix or something, I don't know.

311: Ok, are these like large dogs or medium dogs?

Caller: they're big dogs, they are big and mean.

311: Ok, and what is the color of the dogs?

Caller: One is black and the other is like dark brown, I wouldn't say chocolate, I would say like a dark (unintelligible)

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

## BACKGROUND

The use of eminent domain is being pursued because the subject property is encumbered with title issues preventing the issuance of a title policy. #### ORDINANCE NO.

An ordinance amending Chapter 7A, "Anti-Litter Regulations," of the Dallas City Code, as amended, by amending Section 7A-2 by adding a shopping cart definition; adding a new Section 7A-3.1, "City Removal of Shopping Cart from a Public Place"; providing that a shopping cart found in a public place shall be treated as litter; providing that, upon collection from a public place, the city may immediately dispose of the shopping cart; amending Section 40, "Possession and Identification of Shopping Carts"; clarifying the definition of shopping cart; deleting the labelling requirements; deleting the provision that the city of Dallas will return the shopping cart to its owner upon payment of a recovery fee; providing a penalty not to exceed \$500; providing a saving clause; providing a severability clause; and providing an effective date.

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that shopping carts thrown or deposited in public places create nuisance conditions that constitute hazards to the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the city of Dallas and are likely to endanger persons and property of the city of Dallas; Now, Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 7A, "Anti-Litter Regulations," of Section 7A-2, "Definitions," of the Dallas City Code, as amended, is amended by adding a new Subsection (14.1) to read as follows:

"(14.1) SHOPPING CART. An object that has the same meaning as in Chapter 17 of the Texas Business and Commerce Code, as amended."

SECTION 2. That Chapter 7A, "Anti-Litter Regulations," of the Dallas City Code, as amended, is amended by adding a new Section 7A-3.1, "City Removal of Shopping Cart from a Public Place," to read as follows:

#### "SEC. 7A-3.1. CITY REMOVAL OF SHOPPING CART FROM A PUBLIC PLACE

(a) A shopping cart found by the city in a public place shall be presumed lost or abandoned, unless the shopping car has:

(1) been reported as stolen to the Dallas Police Department within the last

30 days;

(2) a legible name, address, and telephone number of the owner of the shopping

cart; and

(3) a legible unique identifier, such as a serial number.

(b) A shopping cart found by the city in a public place is hereby declared a public nuisance.

(c) A shopping cart found by the city in a public place shall be considered litter.

(d) Upon collection, the city may immediately dispose of the shopping cart, including recycling it, or the city may temporarily store the shopping cart before disposing of it, whichever method the director, in the director's discretion, deems appropriate. For purposes of this section, DIRECTOR is the director of the department of street services of the city of Dallas."

SECTION 3. That Section 31-40, "Possession and Identification of Shopping Carts" of Chapter 31, "Offenses – Miscellaneous," of the Dallas City Code, as amended, is amended to read

as follows:

#### "SEC. 31-40. POSSESSION [AND IDENTIFICATION] OF SHOPPING CARTS.

(a) In this section, SHOPPING CART is an object that has the same meaning as in Chapter 17 of the Texas Business and Commerce Code, as amended [means any device or conveyance provided by a retail establishment for use by its customers for the transport of merchandise from the retail establishment. The term does not include a motor vehicle as defined in the Texas Transportation Code].

(b) A person commits an offense if he possesses a shopping cart at a location other than the premises of the retail establishment that owns the shopping cart.

#### THIS IS A PRELIMINARY WORKING DRAFT FOR DISCUSSION PURPOSES, AND IS SUBJECT TO ADDITIONAL REVISION.

(c) It is a defense to prosecution under Subsection (b) that the person was an owner, employee, or agent of the retail establishment that owns the shopping cart and was delivering, retrieving, or returning the shopping cart to the retail establishment.

(d) A retail establishment that owns a shopping cart shall affix to the shopping cart a durable, all-weather [, and legible] decal [identifying the name, address, and telephone number of the retail establishment. The decal must also state] stating the following in legible letters:

IT IS AN OFFENSE PUNISHABLE BY A FINE OF UP TO \$500 TO POSSESS THIS SHOPPING CART AT A LOCATION OTHER THAN ON THE PREMISES OF THE RETAIL ESTABLISHMENT THAT OWNS THIS SHOPPING CART.

[(e) A shopping cart recovered by the city of Dallas will be returned to the owner, as determined by the decal affixed to the shopping cart, upon payment to the city of a recovery fee of \$25.]"

SECTION 4. That, unless specifically provided otherwise by this ordinance or by state law, a person violating a provision of this ordinance is, upon conviction, punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500.

SECTION 5. That Chapters 7A and 31 of the Dallas City Code shall remain in full force and effect, save and except as amended by this ordinance.

SECTION 6. That the terms and provisions of this ordinance are severable and are governed by Section 1-4 of Chapter 1 of the Dallas City Code, as amended.

SECTION 7. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Dallas, and it is accordingly so ordained.

## SUBJECT Upcoming Agenda Item: Dallas Midtown Phase 1 Project in the Mall Area Redevelopment TIF District

On June 22, 2016, City Council will be asked to consider authorizing a development agreement with Midtown Development, Inc. ("Owner") and/or its affiliates in an amount not to exceed \$36,000,000 payable from future Mall Area Redevelopment TIF District funds in consideration of Owner's completion of Dallas Midtown Phase 1, a catalyst redevelopment project that will include a minimum Owner investment of \$200,000,000 for demolition, infrastructure improvements, vertical construction, and open space assemblage on property currently addressed at 13131, 13331, 13343, and 13439 Preston Road and will both secure the public good and stimulate comprehensive redevelopment of the broader area within Tax Increment Financing Reinvestment Zone Number Twenty (Mall Area Redevelopment TIF District).

Since City Council's creation of the Mall Area Redevelopment TIF District in May 2014, staff has been in negotiations with the Owner (Beck Ventures) regarding the Owner's request for TIF funding to support the megasite redevelopment initiative targeting Valley View Center Mall and the surrounding area (commonly known as "Midtown"). In early May 2016, staff and the Owner reached agreement on terms for a proposed TIF development agreement for the Dallas Midtown Phase 1 project. On June 8, 2016, the Mall Area Redevelopment TIF District Board of Directors unanimously recommended approval of the proposed TIF development agreement in an amount not to exceed \$36,000,000 payable from future Mall Area Redevelopment TIF District funds.

On June 20, 2016, a briefing about the project and proposed TIF development agreement will also be provided to the Economic Development Committee.

## BACKGROUND

## **Dallas Midtown Phase 1 Project:**

The Dallas Midtown Phase 1 project is planned for an approximate 14-acre portion of the existing Valley View Center mall area (an approximate 115-acre super-block) generally bounded by LBJ Freeway (IH 635), Preston Road, Alpha Road, and Montfort Drive. This proposed catalyst project will not occur without TIF funding support and will remove barriers to the comprehensive redevelopment of the Montfort-IH 635 Sub-District ("Sub-District") described in the Mall Area Redevelopment TIF District Project Plan and Reinvestment Zone Financing Plan ("Plan").

Investment of TIF funding in this catalyst project will secure, among other public benefits, the construction of quality mixed income housing, the initial assembly of public open space, significant horizontal construction of new public roads/utilities and vertical construction of new buildings in conformance with urban design standards, minority/women-owned business enterprise inclusion, and the demolition of obsolete facilities to prepare the way for comprehensive redevelopment in the Sub-District. Dallas Midtown Phase 1 will support increased density and diversified uses (e.g. housing, retail, office, entertainment, hospitality, and open space uses) in a pedestrian-oriented development pattern that will enhance economic vibrancy and quality of life in the area and provide permanent employment opportunities.

Built in 1973, the Valley View Center mall is economically and physically obsolete, impairing redevelopment in the area. The Dallas Midtown Phase 1 project is planned to include:

- unencumberance, vacation, environmental remediation, and demolition of the existing in-line mall (including the AMC theater), the former JC Penney anchor building, the former Dillard's anchor building, and the appurtenant parking structure;
- extensive site work (e.g. excavation; placement of fill; grading);
- infrastructure improvements (e.g. construction of new roads and utilities) necessary to prepare four (4) new blocks for the construction of new vertical improvements on those blocks;
- construction of new vertical improvements totaling approximately 897,550 gross square feet (excluding parking structures) of space in a mixed use configuration, including:
  - movie theater (approximately 48,900 gross square feet; approximately 10 screens; approximately 1,000 seats)
  - retail/restaurant/entertainment space (approximately 251,700 gross square feet)
  - office space (approximately 76,900 gross square feet)
  - multi-family rental residential units (approximately 359,910 gross square feet; approximately 310 units, 20% of which will be restricted as affordable according to the District's mixed income housing requirements)
  - full-service hotel (approximately 160,140 gross square feet; approximately 204 rooms)
- construction of integrated parking structures (4 multi-level structures totaling approximately 2,400 spaces);
- construction of open space totaling approximately 30,000 square feet (privately owned; privately maintained; publicly accessible); and
- conveyance by dedication to the City of two (2) tracts of real property (totaling approximately 4,134 square feet) for potential future use as public

open space, subject to City securing additional real property for potential future use as public open space from the adjacent land owner to the west.

The anticipated total cost of Dallas Midtown Phase 1, including costs expended to date, is approximately \$350 million, comprised of the following components: (i) land acquisition costs of approximately \$60 million and (ii) development (horizontal and vertical) costs of approximately \$290 million. The Owner's project scope, as it relates to the proposed TIF development agreement, includes a minimum required private investment in development (horizontal and vertical) costs of \$200 million.

In addition to the timely completion of the above site work and improvements, the disbursement of TIF funding shall be subject to the following requirements:

- Affordable Housing: Owner shall reserve 20% (approximately 62 units) of the 310 units in the multi-family residential component included in Dallas Midtown Phase 1 as affordable according to the District's mixed income housing requirements (including a mix of affordable units by type and a spatial dispersion of affordable units within the development).
- Business Inclusion and Development: In addition to complying with a Business Inclusion and Development ("BID") goal of 25% for the TIF reimbursable improvements (hard construction costs only), Owner shall make a good faith effort to achieve a goal of certified minority/womenowned business enterprise (M/WBE) participation for the private improvements (hard construction costs only) of 15% of total private expenditures and meet all reporting requirements for each.
- Urban Design Review: The project has undergone extensive design review with the City Design Studio/Urban Design Peer Review Panel ("UDPRP"). Following reviews on March 20, May 8, and October 23, 2015, the UDPRP made design recommendations for various components of the project. On November 9, 2015, the Owner provided an UDPRP response and an updated drawings submittal to the City Design Studio. On November 12, 2015, City Design Studio indicated that the materials provided by the Owner satisfied the requirement for design review related to the Owner's application for TIF funding assistance for Dallas Midtown Phase 1. For each component of Dallas Midtown Phase 1, Owner shall also be required to submit a set of permit drawings to the CityDesign Studio for internal review at or before the time of permit submittal to ensure substantial conformance with the UDPRP recommendations and responses.

TIF funding will be used for (i) environmental remediation and demolition (net of salvage value)--\$1,000,000; (ii) public infrastructure improvements (e.g. roads, utilities, and streetscape)--\$19,000,000; (iii) an economic development grant to secure the public benefit that arises from accommodating high density development in an urban form and providing public open space, both of which

have a sub-district-wide benefit--\$4,000,000; and (iv) an economic development grant to secure the public benefit of including high quality affordable housing in an area of opportunity--\$12,000,000. Expenditures may be shifted from one TIF-eligible sub-category to another as long as the total amount of TIF funding does not exceed \$36,000,000 and as long as the total amount of the economic development grant portion does not exceed \$18,000,000. No TIF funding will be disbursed until all conditions of the development agreement have been satisfied by Owner and only if and when TIF funds are available. No TIF funding will be available on an "up front" basis.

The project meets TIF Grant Program Guidelines as a new development that will promote within the District: (a) development and diversification of the economy, (b) elimination of unemployment and underemployment, (c) development/expansion of residential, transportation, business, and commercial activity, (d) high density development in an urban form, (e) public open space, and (f) high quality mixed income housing. The project is not financially viable without the TIF grant.

## Mall Area Redevelopment TIF District:

The Mall Area Redevelopment TIF District was created by City Council in May 2014 to stimulate private investment and sustain the orderly redevelopment and revitalization of the Valley View Center Mall area and the Southwest Center Mall area, two commercial core assets of the City.

As allowed by Chapter 311 of the Texas Tax Code ("TIF Act"), the District comprises two non-contiguous sub-districts: (1) the Montfort-IH 635 Sub-District for the Valley View Center Mall area and (2) the Westmoreland-IH 20 Sub-District for the Southwest Center Mall area.

The Montfort-IH 635 Sub-District is generally bounded by Alpha Road, Preston Road, Noel Road, and Interstate Highway 635 (LBJ Freeway). The Montfort-IH 635 Sub-District encompasses approximately 174 acres, not including rights-of-way. The Montfort-IH 635 Sub-District was recommended by and is consistent with the City's adopted Valley View-Galleria Area Plan (May 2013) and serves a long-term funding tool to help implement the shared vision for the area by further leveraging other implementation tools (PD 887 form-based zoning district and Thoroughfare Plan) enacted by City Council in 2013 (and amended in 2015 and 2016).

The Westmoreland-IH 20 Sub-District is generally bounded by Westmoreland Road, Camp Wisdom Road, Highway 67 (Marvin D. Love Freeway), and Interstate Highway 20 (LBJ Freeway). The Westmoreland-IH 20 Sub-District encompasses approximately 97 acres, not including rights-of-way. The Westmoreland-IH 20 Sub-District was recommended by and is consistent with the City-sponsored Advisory Services Panel report entitled "Southwest Center Mall" published by the Urban Land Institute (2009) and serves as a long-term funding tool to help implement many of the report's recommendations over time.

Originally, the Valley View Center Mall and the Southwest Center Mall were created by complex configurations of super-blocks, private land ownership, and reciprocal easement agreements that bound multiple owners together. Over the last decade as market conditions have shifted significantly, these same configurations have heavily burdened each mall area, making redevelopment and revitalization extremely challenging without public participation.

With the assistance of the Mall Area Redevelopment TIF District, each mall area is to be reconfigured over time into a traditional pattern of public streets, public open space, public infrastructure, and smaller parcels of private land ownership, thereby setting the stage for incremental redevelopment that is flexible to meet market and community needs.

The City's participation in the District is scheduled as follows: 0% in 2015; 90% from 2016 through 2042; 75% in 2043; and 55% in 2044. Dallas County's participation (authorized by the Commissioners Court in August 2015) is scheduled to begin on January 1, 2020, subject to Valley View Center Mall (excluding Sears and the existing theater) being demolished by the same date, by providing 55% of its increment for either 20 years, until the County's total net present value contribution reaches \$21.6 million (using a discount rate of 4%), or the City of Dallas terminates the District, whichever comes first.

For its 30-year term, the District's Plan forecasts planned private development projects and public expenditures necessary to support the private investment. The City of Dallas will contribute up to \$384.6 million in total dollars (\$160.9 million NPV 2014 dollars) to the District. Dallas County will contribute up to \$46.7 million in total dollars (\$21.6 million NPV 2014 dollars) to the District. The District's total budget is approximately \$431.4 million (\$182.5 million NPV 2014 dollars).

When the Mall Area Redevelopment TIF District was created by City Council in 2014, it was set up to facilitate tax increment revenue sharing from the Montfort-IH 635 Sub-District in order to jump start redevelopment activity in the Westmoreland-IH 20 Sub-District. Pursuant to the District's Plan, ten percent (10%) of the annual tax increment generated by the Montfort-IH 635 Sub-District (less payment of annual administrative expenses) will be transferred to the Westmoreland-IH 20 Sub-District to help facilitate the revitalization and redevelopment of the Southwest Center Mall area. It is estimated that up to \$39.2 million will be transferred to the Westmoreland-IH 20 Sub-District over the term of the District. It is estimated that approximately \$4.3 million will be specifically generated by the Dallas Midtown Phase 1 project and transferred to the Westmoreland-IH 20 Sub-District over the remaining 25-26 years of the District's term.

Under the authority of the TIF Act, the District's Project Plan Improvements consists of a program of administration and implementation, public infrastructure improvements, economic development grants, and land acquisition/assembly for public open space, which is intended to stimulate private investment in the area to occur earlier and to a much greater extent than would occur solely through private investment in the reasonably foreseeable future.

With City and County participation, the cumulative increased real property value in the District is estimated to reach approximately \$4.2 billion during the life of the District, including approximately \$3.75 billion in increased taxable real property value attributable to new private investment and \$471 million in increased taxable real property value attributable to property appreciation.

Over the 30-year life of the District, the planned private development program includes:

- approximately 9,000 new residential units
- approximately 900,000 square feet of new retail space
- approximately 4,000,000 square feet of new office space
- approximately 1,000 new hotel rooms
