SUBJECT Sales Tax Receipts

The December 2020 sales tax receipts from the State Comptroller's Office are \$35.9 million, which represent a 1.8 percent increase in <u>total collections</u> compared to the same reporting period last year. However, this year we received \$2.5 million from the State Comptroller's Office as part of an audit finding from a prior period. When comparing <u>current period collections</u> which excludes the audit finding, our receipts for December 2020 are 4 percent less when compared to the same reporting period last year. Over the most recent 12 months, sales tax receipts have decreased by 4.5 percent, due to the effects of the COVID-19 outbreak and the subsequent economic decline.

Including the positive audit finding, our receipts are \$5.4 million better than budget for the month of December and \$10.9 million better than budget for the first quarter of this fiscal year. Since sales tax receipts continue to exceed the budgeted amount, we are working with our economist, Dearmon Analytics, LLC, to revise our sales tax forecast and will provide additional information as it becomes available.








Sales Tax
