Redistricting

The Redistricting Commission met on Monday, April 25 at 3:30 p.m. via videoconference and at Dallas City Hall – Council Chambers. They heard two final map submittal presentations and they approved one for further consideration. They began the selection of the 3 preferred plans, which were $\underline{COD} - \underline{017}$, $\underline{COD} - \underline{040}$ and $\underline{COD} - \underline{041}$ and then selected their top two preferred plans $\underline{COD} - \underline{017}$ and $\underline{COD} - \underline{041}$.

They plan to start the amendment process on those two preferred plans on Monday, May 2 at 3:30 p.m. at Dallas City Hall – Council Chambers. Residents will have an opportunity to share feedback to those amended maps during a public hearing at City Hall – Council Chambers on Saturday, May 7 at 3 p.m. Individuals who would like to offer feedback during the May 7 public hearing must register at <u>bit.ly/2021RDCTH</u> by 10 a.m. the day of the meeting.

Commissioners plan to select their final map on Monday, May 9 and plan to submit their final proposal to the Mayor on Monday, May 16. Individuals who wish to

OHS Street Outreach Update

The DRTRR team of homeless service providers, co-led by OHS and MDHA, is currently targeting several encampments, which will result in closure through the housing of those unsheltered individuals throughout the year. The team will outreach to these sites and meet with various persons experiencing homelessness to assess their needs in preparation for site closure via housing. During this time, the OHS Street Outreach Team will continue to engage with unsheltered residents through normal street outreach, connecting people with the needed resources, such as: getting IDs, working with Community Courts on expunging eligible tickets and offenses from their records, identifying medical needs, and getting them access to the Coordinated Access System (CAS). 


