## SUBJECT U.S. Small Business Administration Disaster Loan Outreach Center Closure

The U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA) has notified the Office of Emergency Management (OEM) that they intend to close the two Disaster Loan Outreach Centers (DLOCs) later this month. The DLOC at Samuell-Grand Recreation Center will close on Thursday, October 20<sup>th</sup>, 2022, and the DLOC at the Balch Springs Recreation Center will close on Thursday, October 27<sup>th</sup>, 2022. OEM will promote the closure of these two sites alongside the SBA.
