SUBJECT Park and Recreation Department Accreditation

We are most pleased to announce that the Dallas Park and Recreation Department has formally been designated as an accredited park and recreation agency. The official announcement took place last night at the Best of the Best Awards Ceremony at the National Recreation and Park Association (NRPA) Convention in St. Louis, Missouri. The President and a majority of the Park and Recreation Board as well as a contingent of department staff were in attendance as the award was presented to Park and Recreation Board Recreation Board President Max Wells.

In 2013, at the behest of the Park and Recreation Board, the Park and Recreation Department undertook the rigorous accreditation process administered by the Commission for Accreditation of Parks and Recreation Agencies (CAPRA), which is affiliated with the National Park and Recreation Association (NRPA). CAPRA only grants accreditation to a select number of departments that exhibit excellence in service and operations and adhere to national best practices as demonstrated by compliance with 151 standards of excellence.

The three-step accreditation process included the submission of a self-assessment that contained thousands of pages of agency information; a three-day site visit by the CAPRA visitation team that began with a welcome by Mayor Mike Rawlings at the Dallas Arboretum; and tours of recreation centers, parks, maintenance facilities, leisure venue sites and administrative offices in order to evaluate the Dallas park system and services and to verify compliance with national standards. The process concluded with a formal hearing by the CAPRA Commission conducted during the NRPA annual convention in St. Louis.

Achieving accreditation has been a high priority of the Park and Recreation Board and the Department for three years. Accreditation signifies that the Department utilizes national best practices in all facets of the organization from recreation programs to park maintenance standards to business operations. Since its inception in 1993, less than 2% of departments and agencies in the country have attained accreditation. It is a prestigious and exclusive recognition that demonstrates our commitment to achieving or exceeding the highest standards of the park and recreation profession.
