SUBJECT Encampment Resolution Update

The purpose of this memorandum is to provide the City Council with an update on the OHS encampment resolution strategy concerning all encampments on Parks land and the sites cleaned by OHS this week and scheduled for next week.

Resolution on Park Encampments

Encampments on Parks land pose a health and safety risk in line with those required to be clear in the encampment resolutions memo. Therefore, sites on Parks land are being prioritized by Parks and OHS in order of magnitude, decided by location, size, and issues unique to the individual areas. Per CDC guidelines, housing via shelter services will continue to be offered to all encampment residents by OHS. An updated resolution containing this prioritization will be released next week.
