TO Honorable Mayor and Members of the City Council

SUBJECT GA Landing Fee

As you are aware, Dallas Love Field continues to enjoy a high level of activity from both commercial as well as general aviation flights. The Airfield Cost Center for the maintenance and operations of the airfield. Includes all the expenses necessary to ensure the safe and efficient movement of aircraft at our busy airport. The Aviation Enterprise funds recovers these costs via landing fees based on the weight of all aircraft using the airfield. The City enacted general aviation landing fee in January 2019 to more equitably distribute these costs among the users of the airfield. The general aviation landing fee of \$5.15 per 1,000 pounds has been assessed for flights in CY2019.

Landing fees are recalculated every six months to assure the airport is not over or under collecting, and based on the airfield operation and maintenance cost forecasted in FY19-20, the GA landing fee was increased to \$5.91 on February 1, 2020 to cover the estimated \$4,575,020 in expenses.
