SUBJECT Living Wage Update

The City of Dallas implemented a living wage policy for general services contracts on November 10, 2015 by Resolution No. 15-2141. The policy requires an annual adjustment according to the Massachusetts Institute of Technology's Living Wage Calculator, found here: <u>https://livingwage.mit.edu/counties/48113</u>. For 2020, the living wage for an individual in Dallas County is \$12.38 per hour (an increase from the 2019 rate of \$11.71 per hour).

The Office of Procurement Services adjusts the living wage for its general services contracts each year on October 1, to align with the City's fiscal year. Accordingly, solicitations for general services contracts advertised after October 1, 2020 will include the \$12.38 per hour living wage, and that wage will apply for the term of the contract. Examples of general services include landscaping, janitorial, and administrative work.
