

REPORT OF CANVASSING COMMITTEE AND
RESOLUTION AND ORDER APPROVING REPORT

TO THE HONORABLE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL:

We, the undersigned, your Committee of the City Council appointed on March 6, 1985, to canvass the returns of the election held in the City of Dallas on April 6, 1985, for the purpose of electing eleven members of the City Council and submitting to the qualified voters of the City certain questions as to amending the Charter of the City of Dallas, hereby report that we have carefully canvassed the returns of the election and we submit the tabulated statement of the votes received by the respective candidates and propositions, attached hereto as Exhibit "A."

On the basis of the statement of the returns of the election, it appears that candidates received the following number of votes:

It appears that no candidate for Place Number 1, 2, or 7 received sufficient votes to be elected to the City Council.

It appears that a request for a recount has been filed in accordance with Article 7.15, Subdivision 23 of the Texas Election Code for Place Nos. 9 and 11; therefore, the canvassing of the election returns for Place Nos. 9 and 11 is deferred.

In accordance with Ordinance Nos. 18625, 18626, 18627, and 18628, the following propositions were submitted to the qualified voters of the City of Dallas:

PROPOSITION NO. 1

REAPPOINTMENT OF CITY TREASURER

Shall Chapter III, Section 20 of the Charter of the City of Dallas be amended to authorize the city council to reappoint the city treasurer for one additional two-year term without readvertising for bids?

PROPOSITION NO. 2

APPOINTMENT OF MUNICIPAL JUDGES

Shall Chapter VIII, Section 4 of the Charter of the City of Dallas be amended to provide for the appointment of municipal judges in May of even-numbered years?

PROPOSITION NO. 3

EMPLOYEE REASSIGNMENT

Shall Chapter XVI, Section 6 of the Charter of the City of Dallas be amended to limit to two years the period during which an employee who is reassigned because of departmental reorganization is protected from reduction in compensation?

PROPOSITION NO. 4

TRIAL BOARD MEMBERS AND PROCEDURES

Shall Section 1 and Section 12 of Chapter XVI of the Charter of the City of Dallas be amended to provide for appointment of adjunct members of the civil service board having qualifications established by the city council to serve on trial boards in place of city council members and to authorize the city council to appoint a secretary to the trial board?


