First, on the list is the venue and the request that the MLK Center staff get those quotes completed. Second, the events are to be completed during the holiday weekend with the Candle Light Ceremony taking place on Friday, the Gala taking place that Saturday, and the Parade on the Monday holiday. Board Member Embler reported that Board Member Woodberry received notice that the parade would be outsourced. As well as that the board needed to give input into the parameters of the parade.

2021 CENTER CULTURAL EVENTS

MLK Fresh Produce Distribution served 1,020 families during the month of April. The distribution is still taking place every Saturday at 9:30am at the Park South YMCA during the Covid-19 pandemic.
