DISCUSSION & VOTE: 2024 MLK GALA

Chair Brown-Trimble turned it over to Vice Chair Wicks. Vice Chair Wicks called for a motion to retract and rename the original Trail Blazer Award winner due to some conflicts and name the second-place winner Commissioner Price. After discussion, the board called for the vote, and it was 7-0 for the Trail Blazer Award to go to Commissioner John W. Price.

2024 MLK CELEBRATION WEEK

Chair Brown-Trimble turned it over to Dr. Slaughter. Dr. Slaughter stated that the we are still working on the marketing/outreach plan. But, ask that when the full sponsorship packets and marketing materials are ready for release that each board member shares with their network. We did change the look of the sponsorship packet to make it clear as to what the potential sponsors will receive for their sponsor dollars. 2023 CENTER CULTURAL EVENTS

The MLK Fresh Produce Distribution, managed by Miles of Freedom, served 1,012 families during the month of June and 1,215 families during the month of July at both locations. The distribution is still taking place every Saturday at 9:30 a.m. at the Park South YMCA and there are new hours at the center. The new hours are Monday – Thursday, from 10 a.m.-12 p.m. All board members and citizens are encouraged to volunteer and help plan the many cultural events; you can get that information online at www.dallasmlkcenter.com.

Legal Aid of NW Texas has returned to the building, and they see the first 30 people on the second and fourth Tuesday of each month. The review of events: LIRA MLK Journey Next Steps took place on Saturday, July 8, 2023 with 23 graduates and 150 attendees. A Shower of Blessings took place on Wednesday, July 12, 2023 had 150 attendees. Back to School Festival took place on Saturday, August 12, 2023 served 235 families and 1,661 students in attendance. Empowering the Masses MLK Phlebotomy and Community Health Worker Graduation took place on Saturday, August 19, 2023 with 11 Phlebotomy and 9 Community Health Worker Certifications.
