Chair's Welcome & Work Plan

Presenter(s): Rafael Anchia

Discussion Item(s): Chair Anchia gave a recap of the meeting held March 18, 2014 where the Commission further discussed council pay and terms. Chair Anchia requested that commissioners send proposals to city staff regarding suggested charter amendments. Chair Anchia announced interpreters will be providing simultaneous Spanish language translation during the next scheduled community meetings. The work plan was outlined for the meeting scheduled for April 1, 2014. Topics for discussion include:

- Civil Service Presentations
- Presentation from the City Attorney
- Vote on three outstanding technical amendments
- Vote on appointment, forfeiture and attendance policy for boards and commissions
- Vote on prohibition on financial interest of Employees or Officers in public contracts

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related issues. April 15, 2014 is the due date to discuss these proposed amendments. April 29, 2014 is set as the date to vote on proposed amendments concerning:

- Mayor/Council pay and terms
- Boards and commissions
- Redistricting
- Civil Service

Remaining suggested amendments with no support from a commissioner will not be included on the working list after April 15, 2014.

<u>Dallas 2011 Redistricting Process, a Citizen's Perspective</u>

Mr. Betzen suggested that any time a district border is altered on the map supporting documentation should accompany the change. Mr. Betzen is a proponent of an independent redistricting commission.
