Subject UPDATED: Comparison of Top 5 Texas Cities Petition Verification Requirements

Listed below is an update to the information provided to you on April 18, 2014 following Commissioner Hart Black's request for more information on the prescribed number of days the City Secretary/City Clerk, according to its city charter, allows for petition verification for the top 5 Texas cities.

This update provides additional information for the Cities of Austin and El Paso, following discussions with the respective City Clerk/City Secretary on other matters which are addressed via separate memorandum on this same issue.

NOTE: Verification of 1st filing on a referendum/initiative petition is 30 days; if City Council does not adopt the proposed change, does not present the item to the voters or rejects the petition overall, the filer is given another 20 days, under the same petition circulation process, to resubmit an exact replica of the petition with new signatures and the same signature requirement as the first petition. If the 2nd petition is found to have sufficient signatures, it must be either approved by the City Council or presented to the voters.
