SUBJECT

Authorize approval of the revised Golf Course Operations Policy – Financing: No cost consideration to the City

BACKGROUND

The Park and Recreation Board approves the Golf Course Operations Policy, which was last revised and approved on January 19, 2017. All policies established by the Park and Recreation Board must comply with City Code, City Charter, and State Law. All Golf Pro contracts should reference this Policy.

Staff has revised the Golf Course Operations Policy to include the following updates and revisions:

- 1. Revised references to this document as an "Administrative Directive for Golf Course Operations" to read as "Golf Course Operations Policy".
- 2. Section A.3. added the City's right to close the golf course for public health safety precautions.
- 3. Section G.7. added the Pro Shop staff are not allowed to search golf bags, back packs, or purses for alcoholic beverages.
- 4. Section H.2. and H.3. removed both sections which referred to Senior Annual Cards and Private Cart Annual Cards, as both are no longer offered.
- 5. Section J.1. revised reference to "Assistant Director of Administration/Business Services" to read as "Park and Recreation Department Assistant Director" for simplicity and versatility.
- 6. Section L. revised and rearranged regulations in this section to emphasize the prohibition of alcohol and personal coolers brought onto golf course property; outlined the action necessary when alcohol and personal coolers are brought on property; and clarified the implications of violations and frequent offenders.

This action requests the Board to adopt the proposed Golf Course Operations Policy.

BACKGROUND

This action will award a contract for construction of the Flagpole Hill – Phase One Improvements. This project was included in the 2017 Bond Program.

The scope of work includes construction of new parking lots, a new ceremonial approach to the historic flagpole, 10'-0" wide Multi-Use Trail, relocation of existing lighting fixtures, new lighting and electrical, site furniture.

On May 5, 2021, the City of Dallas advertised for bids for the Flagpole Hill – Phase One Improvements. In response to the advertisement, the Office of Procurement Services received bids from five (5) firms on May 21, 2021.





SUBJECT

Authorize an agreement with The Trust for Public Land for the purpose of design and construction of Woody Branch Park located at 4900 South RL Thornton Freeway – Financing: No cost consideration to the City

BACKGROUND

This item authorizes an agreement with The Trust for Public Land (TPL) for the design, and phased development of Woody Branch Park. TPL, shall be responsible for funding, public input process, and design of the park development—the City may participate in funding, subject to appropriations, and may choose to bid and mange construction.

Woody Branch Park was identified in the *Five Mile Creek Urban Greenbelt* master plan, Focus Area B, as a potential acquisition which would provide resident-access to the Five Mile Creek Trail corridor along Woody Branch. The park was acquired by the City in collaboration with TPL. TPL facilitated acquisition of the property by funding due diligence and negotiating acquisition with the prior owner.

The City's acquisition of the property from TPL on June 14, 2021 was funded with Reforestation Funds. As such, the development of the land is restricted to minimize impact to trees and the supporting ecosystem. The property contains open space on the north and south ends of the property which are favorable to development without impacting the existing forestland, as required of land purchased with Reforestation Funds. Planning and development of the park will be cognizant of these restraints—any design improvements in forestland will treat the forest as an asset to the community.

TPL will engage the public in the development of a park master plan. After Park Board approval of the master plan the park is expected to be developed in phases depending upon feasibility and funding. TPL will facilitate design through development of the project to close out or, if the project is phased, through completion of each phase of the project.

The agreement will be subject to the following terms:

1. TPL shall hold public meetings and fund: design of a master plan, construction documents, and construction. TPL may potentially bid and manage construction of such improvements.

- a. City may participate in funding of the project, subject to appropriations.
- b. City reserves right to bid and manage construction of each or any phase of the project.
- 2. Master plan is anticipated to include attractions and features such as: pavilion, signature botanic elements, trails, playground, ecological restoration, and educational elements about the ecological and environmental qualities of the the park. After Park Board approval of the master plan for Woody Branch Park TPL shall develop construction drawings subject to raising funds.
- 3. Plan and development shall respect requirements of the Reforestation Fund. City Forester shall participate in development of the master plan and construction drawings as appropriate.
- 4. If TPL constructs improvements, City shall assist TPL to secure all permits, platting, and other City requirements, and all state and federal requirements as required.
- 5. City shall maintain park improvements upon acceptance and close out of the project or phase. TPL shall have no maintenance or operations obligations of the park improvements after close out of each phase of project.
- 6. The term of the agreement is the duration of the design and construction of the park through the initial warranty of construction improvements, or, if the project is phased, through design, construction, and warranty of each phase of the project.



SUBJECT

BACKGROUND

On January 22, 2020 the City entered into a Grant Agreement (Agreement) with the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department for acceptance of a \$1,000,000.00 grant. The grant was included at the end of the 86th legislative session on May 31, 2019 and passage on June 15, 2019 under House Bill 1, Article IX, Sec. 18.100 which appropriated \$1,000,000.00 in the state's fiscal year 2020 budget for the purpose of making a grant to the City for the design and development of the future Judge Charles R. Rose Community Park.

The Agreement terminates August 31, 2021. This first amendment provides for a termination date of August 31, 2023. Additionally, the Agreement provides clarification to and provides for the ability of the City to collaborate with a non-profit organization (The Trust for Public Land) in carrying out the City's Agreement obligations including the ability to transfer funds to the non-profit organization pursuant to said Agreement.

PRIOR ACTION/REVIEW (COUNCIL, BOARDS, COMMISSIONS)

On April 4, 2019, the Park and Recreation Board authorized the placeholder name of Simpson Stuart Park, the acquisition of the 3200 Simpson Stuart Rd from TPL, and execution of a Development and Funding Agreement with TPL for the collaborative design and development of the future park.

On April 24, 2019, City Council authorized a development and funding agreement with The Trust for Public Land for property located at 3200 Simpson Stuart Road for a proposed new park; and acquisition from The Trust for Public Land of approximately 1,760,971 square feet of land located at 3200 Simpson Stuart Road by Resolution No. 19-0606.

Authorize Amendment No. 1 to the Judge Charles R. Rose Community Park Grant Agreement with the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department to extend the term of the agreement and provide for cooperation by the City with a non-profit organization - Financing: No cost consideration to the City – Page 2

On October 24, 2019, the Park and Recreation Board authorized acceptance of a grant from the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department and execution of a Memorandum of Agreement.

On November 13, 2019, Council authorized acceptance of a grant from the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department and execution of a Memorandum of Agreement by Resolution No. 19-1786.

On January 14, 2021, the Park and Recreation Board authorized the change of the park name to Judge Charles R. Rose Community Park.

On January 29, 2021 the Park and Recreation Board authorized adoption of the Judge Charles R. Rose Community Park Master Plan.






Map

BACKGROUND

This change order scope includes: work related to the addition of Hose Bibb at the Senior Center, repair of glass blocks, additional framing at Senior Center, asbestos/lead survey at existing building, provide and install additional HVAC System in equipment room, repair masonry in existing building, add additional support angles at the Senior Center, add additional drain lines, revision of structural support for kitchen overhead door at Senior Center, add additional 64 days to the contract time.
