BACKGROUND

The purpose of a service price agreement is to establish firm pricing for services, for a specific term, which are ordered on an as needed basis. This action does not encumber funds.

Southern Skates Roller Rink is a City owned facility that has been serving the Dallas community for over 10 years. Southern Skates offers multiple open skate times as well as opportunities to plan birthday parties and private events.

This service price agreement will be primarily used to provide disc jockey (DJ) services and event management for birthday parties, special themed events and private gatherings. In addition, the Contractor will serve as the master of ceremonies to announce special activities, and safety rules.

The scope of work for this service shall include the provision of a qualified DJ equipped with appropriate soundboards and mixing equipment to interface with the audio and video projection system at the Southern Skates Roller Rink. The awarded Contractor will be tasked with creating a positive experience for customers that range from advanced to beginner skaters.

<u>SUBJECT</u>

Authorize (1) the demolition of the existing foundation pad for a sculpture donated to the City of Dallas and installed in 2011 called Whimsy, and (2) the construction of a new foundation pad for the addition of an new donation of sculpture, Wise, so the two sculptures can be installed side by side on the northwest corner of Exall Park, located at 1355 Adair Street - Financing: No cost consideration to the City

BACKGROUND

In 2011, artists Brad Oldham and Christy Coltrin donated a polished stainless-steel sculpture of an owl, 'Whimsy" at the northwest corner of Exall Park. The artists have created a companion piece of art named "Wise", also an owl, constructed of stainless steel to be placed proximate to Whimsy. A new plaque will be included with the art installation-text attached.

Artist Brad Oldham, the artist for both sculptures, will demolish the existing pad and construct a new foundation pad and (re)install both sculptures: Whimsy and Wise side by side in the same location at the northwest corner of Exall Park, near the intersection of Bryan Street and Skiles Street.

The neighborhood association and Friends of Exall Park support this donation. Friends of Exall Park will maintain the sculpture as they have done for "Whimsy" since 2011.

The value of the sculpture and installation is \$11,000.00

ARTIST'S BACKGROUND

Brad Oldham and Christy Coltrin are a husband-and-wife team who together create place-making sculptures for communities, companies, and collectors across the country. Over their 20 -year collaboration their work has earned recognition from national arts organizations, media, and their peers. The Brad Oldham Sculpture workshop, office, and store are located in downtown Dallas.

They have artwork installed throughout Dallas. The three-site installation near Deep Ellum is known collectively as *The Traveling Man*. The *Twist* is a 30-foot-long sculptural installation at Park District near Klyde Warren Park. The *Running with the Moon* is a 31-foot-tall sculpture cantilevered over the river in San Antonio, and the couple recently completed two monumental installations near the entrance of the Greensboro Children's Museum in North Carolina.

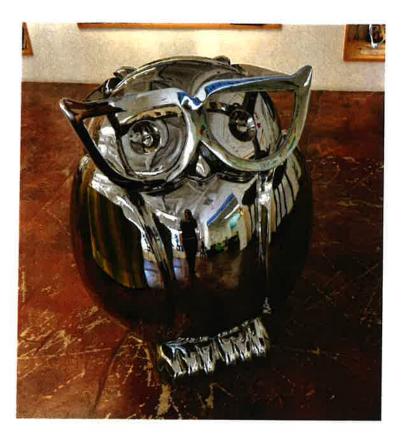

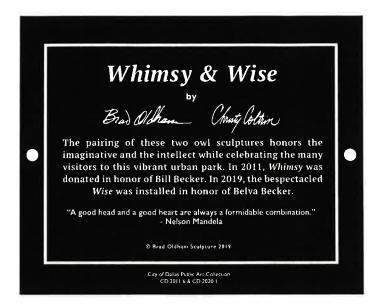
Exall Park Location Map

Donation value of sculpture: \$11,000 donation to the City of Dallas for the sculpture + the design/shop drawings.

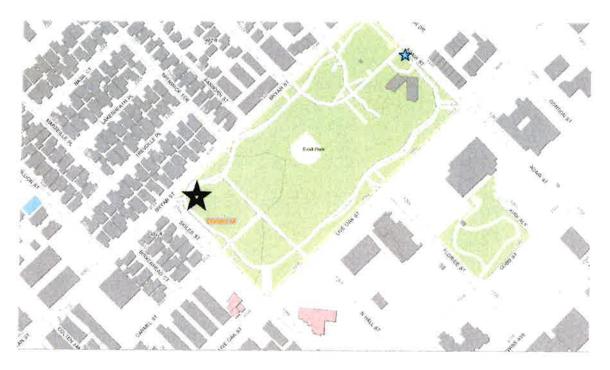

The value of the *Wise* sculpture is accurately noted in the contract below at \$11,000.00 when we made the sculpture in 2019. However, the additional value of our donation to the City of Dallas should reflect the rest of our work. We will demo the existing installation and prepare the Exall Park location for the new installation. We have designed and engineered the new 8' wide x 5' deep x 6" tall concrete pedestal, and we will install this pedestal, providing all materials and labor. We have designed and made a stainless steel Artists' Plaque to be installed on an angled plinth. The two owl sculptures, Whimsy and Wise, will be securely reinstalled along with the Artists' Plaque. The value of this work is \$15,000.00, which is in addition to the value of the sculpture and brings the total donation amount to \$26,000.00.

BACKGROUND

On November 1, 2018, the City entered into a 20-year management agreement with Fair Park First (FPF) to operate, manage, promote, enhance and improve Fair Park. This agreement identified responsibilities on the part of both parties that after reviewing operations since FPF took over, staff and FPF management have identified areas requiring clarification via amendments to the agreement in order to ensure clear responsibilities are identified. Below is a summary of those areas:

ARTICLE III. ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS AND OTHER FISCAL MATTERS

Amend Section 3.01 (c), Payment beginning October 1, 2021, to allow for a fifty percent payment of the Annual Appropriation to be paid on October 1st annually and three other 1/6th payments to be made on January 1st, April 1st, and July 1st of each contract year. This would change the payment from a month-to month payment of the Annual Appropriation.

Amend Section 3.01(f), Capital Improvement Plan Appropriations, to modify payment schedule from a month-to-month payment to a single payment to be made, upon Council Appropriation within 90-days of City's approval of the Capital Improvement Plan as submitted by Fair Park First.

Amend Section 3.02 (a), Use of Funds in Annual Appropriation to Support Resident Institutions, to identify the City as having responsibility for funding the Resident Institutions, comprised of Texas Discovery Gardens, Music Hall at Fair Park, the African American Museum and The Hall of State, while keeping Fair Park First as being responsible for oversight of the Resident Institutions operations. Cultural Stipends for the Resident Institutions will be made directly from the City to the Resident Institutions at the

sole discretion of the City and in accordance with recommendations of the City's Cultural Affairs commission.

Add Section 3.02 (b) to add The Children's Aquarium to the Fair Park First Agreement. This addition will add language to 1) place the management and operations of the Children's Aquarium under Fair Park First; 2) acknowledge that Fair Park First is authorized to negotiate and perform a lease agreement with zoOceanarium and will require performance measures to be set for the operations of the Children's Aquarium; 3) pay Fair Park First a one time, lump sum payment of \$500,000 subject to approval of the Park Board and appropriation by Council. These funds will assist with the operation and maintenance of the Aquarium and the funds are separate and apart from the Annual Appropriation; 4) Fair Park First will report to City on an annual basis all accounting related to the Aquarium Funds.

ARTICLE IV. MANAGEMENT AND OPERATION OF FAIR PARK

Amend Section 4.20, City Access to identify access and inspect Fair Park at all reasonable times for any and all public purposes and may use portions of Fair Park as reasonably necessary, to preserve the health, safety, and welfare of the public. The City's use of Fair Park will be subject to an authorized short-term agreement.

ARTICLE V. UTILITIES, TAXES, INSURANCE, PERFORMANCE BOND AND INDEMNIFICATION

Amend Section 5.01, Utilities, to identify that all utilities for Fair Park shall be in the City's name and the City shall be responsible for securing and paying for all utility Services. City shall provide periodic statements, no less than quarterly, for the utility services and Fair Park First shall continue to reimburse the City for actual costs for all utility services.

Article XIV. GENERAL PROVISIONS

Amend Section 14.03, Security Interests, to clarify language regarding authorized tenants in Fair Park not having ability to mortgage, pledge or encumber its rights and interests without City' prior approval. If City approval is granted, no greater interest in Fair Park property, buildings, facilities or improvements is granted that will be greater than the rights of the City.

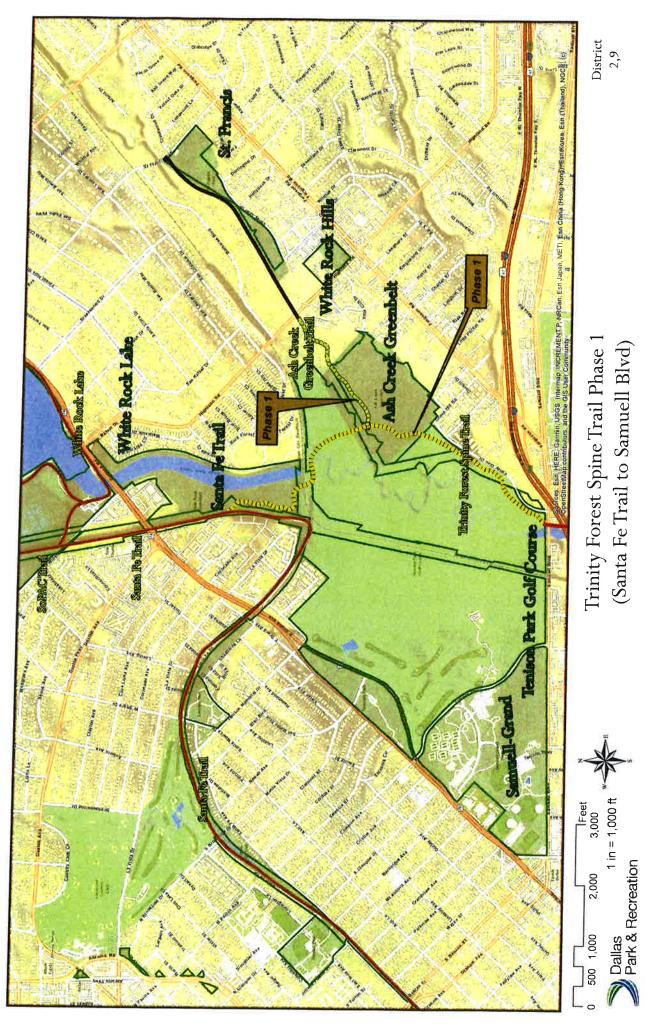

Authorize a professional services contract with TEAM Consultants, Inc. for construction materials testing and inspection services for the Trinity Forest Spine Trail North Phase I located from the Santa Fe Trail to Samuel Boulevard – Not to exceed \$63,246.50 – Financing: Park and Recreation Facilities (B) Funds (2017 General Obligation Bond Funds)

BACKGROUND

This action will authorize a professional services contract with TEAM Consultants, Inc. (TEAM) for construction materials testing and inspection services on Trinity Forest Spine Trail North Phase I, in an amount not to exceed \$63,245.50. TEAM was selected as the most qualified consultant for this project. Materials testing will include soil compaction and concrete strength tests and inspections will include concrete steel reinforcement and welding.

If the contract for the construction of Trinity Forest Spine Trail North Phase I is approved, this contract is needed to provide the specification required materials testing and inspection services to ensure that elements of the trail are being built per the construction documents which will assist in ensuring the longevity of the applicable components.

TEAM is a Dallas-based firm. All five employees that will be assigned to this project are residents of the city of Dallas. TEAM has one Arlington, Texas based M/WBE subconsultant with two Dallas residents assigned to this project.

A contract for the construction of for the Trinity Forest Spine Trail North Phase I located from the Santa Fe Trail to Samuel Boulevard with North Rock Construction, LLC will be considered by separate action on the Park and Recreation Board agenda on May 6, 2021.

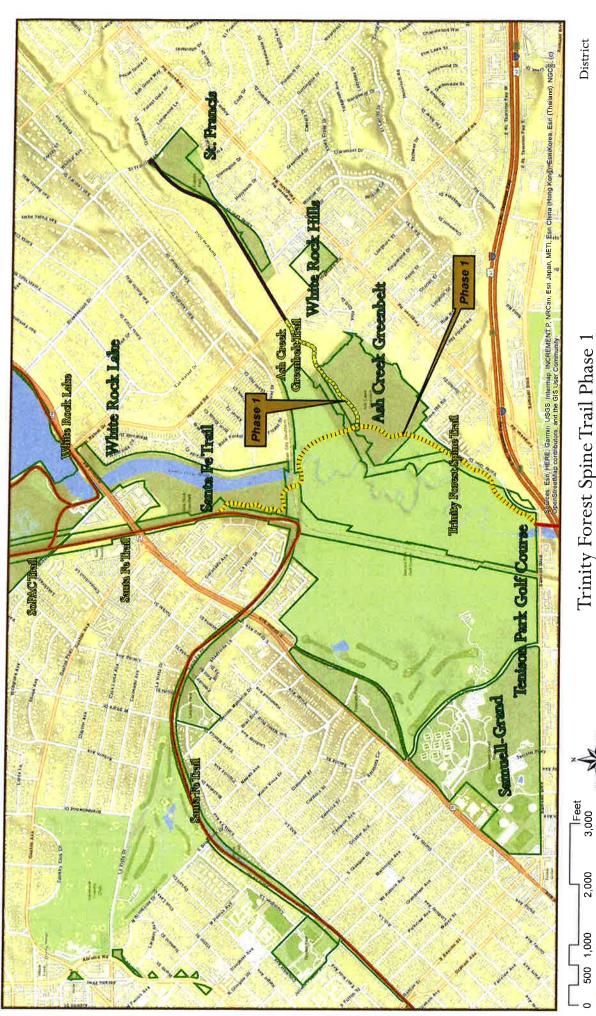

BACKGROUND

The original scope of work consisted of renovation to the Fair Park Coliseum, constructed in 1958. The work included improvements to the mechanical, electrical distribution and lighting systems. The work also included a new fire alarm system, replacement of all the seating in the Arena as well as improvements to the interior ramps and site paving for compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act.

On August 19, 2020, Administrative Action No. 20-1068 authorized Change Order No. 1 to the construction services contract with Azteca Enterprises, Inc. for additional scope of work for the Fair Park Coliseum Facility Improvements Project to include deletions of seating fabric and mechanical system demolition as well as additions to the electrical system, in an amount not to exceed \$46,581.77, from \$10,042,531.00 to \$10,089,112.77.

On September 29, 2020, Administrative Action No. 20-1196 authorized Change Order No. 2 to the construction services contract with Azteca Enterprises, Inc. for additional scope of work for the Fair Park Coliseum Facility Improvements Project to include additional seating in the arena, rerouting a storm line, upgrades to proposed exit signs as well as electrical conduit, feeders and disconnect for an additional transformer, in an amount not to exceed \$49,728.10, from \$10,089, 112.77 to \$10,138,840.87.

On March 15, 2021, Administrative Action No. 21-0109 authorized Change Order No. 4 to the construction services contract with Azteca Enterprises, Inc. for additional scope of work for the Fair Park Coliseum Facility Improvements Project to include additional return air grills, sound attenuators, ductwork, site paving and electrical wiring, in an amount not to exceed \$49,481.08, from \$10,990,198.14 to \$11,039,679.22.
