The Mission

The Mission Began with the Restoration of 3 Historic White Rock Lake Structures

White Rock Boathouse, Inc., a 501(c)(3) non-profit Texas corporation, has reclaimed, restored, and

currently maintains and manages 3 historic structures on the southwest corner of White Rock Lake.

1. The Historic "Boomerang" Restoration





This once-decrepit, historic boathouse has been repurposed by volunteers to house boats for coaching, storage for kayak & stand up paddle boards and water safety equipment.

2. The Filter Building Renovation



The original 1911 White Rock Lake filtration building has been restored into a multi-use event venue to fund White Rock Rowing programs, provide youth subsidies and deliver additional city revenues.






