# **CITY PLAN COMMISSION MINUTES**

The City Plan Commission held a regular Zoning Hearing on April 28, 2005, with the briefing starting at 9:59 a.m. in Room 5ES and the public hearing beginning at 1:38 p.m. in the City Council Chambers of City Hall.
