

PLAN COMMISSION MINUTES

The City Plan Commission held a regular Zoning Hearing on August 20, 2009, with the briefing starting at 10:58 a.m. in Room 5ES and the public hearing at 1:30 p.m. in the City Council Chambers of City Hall. Motion: It was moved to recommend **approval** of a Planned Development District for a Medical clinic or ambulatory surgical center and R-5(A) Single Family District Uses, subject to a development/landscape plan and revised conditions on property zoned an R-5(A) Single Family Subdistrict within Planned Development District No. 595, the South Dallas/Fair Park Special Purpose District, in the east quadrant of Spring Avenue and Foreman Street with the following changes: 1) A new subparagraph under Section 112, SIDEWALKS, to read as follows: "The Director may authorize the realignment of a sidewalk without requiring a minor amendment to the development/landscape plan if the realignment is necessary for the sidewalk to rap around a tree or due to natural features of the property. Realignment of the sidewalk for any other reason must be accomplished through either a minor amendment process or a zoning amendment." 2) Under Section 112, SIDEWALKS, add "In addition to the provision of Section 51A-4.702(h) of the Dallas City Code, Amendment to the Development Plan, the Director of Development Services may authorize minor changes in the development plan

that allow the relocation and of sidewalks in order to protect trees, vary sidewalk layout, width, and integrate sidewalks with architectural features such as benches, plazas, fountains, or other features provided that a minimum sidewalk width of four feet is maintained.” 3) Amend Section 113, SIGNS, to read as follows: “Monument signs may include a changeable message provided no part of a sign may move or rotate and messages can not change more often than one message change in a 60 second period.”
