Our Vision:


- Quickly move individuals out of shelters and into stable, independent housing, and

Implementation Plan:


- Rapidly rehouse 20 people in 90 days
- 22 individuals of 23 who enrolled successfully achieved their housing goal as of January 8, 2021



CLIENT DEMOGRAPHICS


