SUBJECT City Forestry Task Force - Follow Up

Texas A&M Forest Service (TFS) has notified the City Forestry Task Force of the confirmed presence of the Emerald Ash Borer (EAB) within Dallas city limits and western Dallas County. EAB is a non-native wood-boring insect destructive to ash trees. Given ash trees are 5% of the Dallas/Fort Worth urban forest, according to TFS, City staff is prepared to respond. TFS intends to release a formal media advisory later this week. This notification initiates the next steps in the EAB Action Plan.

As part of the City's response, staff will: assess ash trees on public property; treatment of significant ash trees (i.e., 24" or larger in diameter in good condition; large groves of ash trees; etc.) will be occurring; and infected ash trees and damaged ash trees that pose safety issues will be removed.

Staff will increase public awareness and outreach for both the residential and business community. Attached is a flyer that can be distributed to your constituents and pushed through our social media accounts. Staff will provide additional information on status and efforts as part of our quarterly updates to the Environment and Sustainability Committee.

Dallas County will join Denton, Parker, and Tarrant Counties in its quarantine status. This quarantine is mandated by the State through the Texas Department of Agriculture. During this quarantine the moving of ash wood, wood waste, and hardwood firewood products from within Dallas County to other non-quarantined counties is prohibited.
